- All presenters must attend the symposium in person.

Submission Requirements

- All submissions must be sent by 5 p.m. (EST) on Friday, Oct. 27 to Ben Wecht via email at wechtben@duq.edu.
- All submissions must be connected to the JFK assassination.
- All symposium attendees, including students, may submit a research poster abstract for consideration.
- Poster abstracts may be submitted by individuals or groups. (Only one poster per team should be submitted.)
- Poster abstract submissions may come from any of the following academic disciplines:
 - Forensic Science/Investigation
 - Medicine
 - Criminal Law
 - U.S. History
 - o U.S. Political Science
 - Investigative Journalism
- Poster abstract submissions must include the following information **OR** be the completed poster (PDF) that will be presented.
 - o **Title:** A concise title that clearly indicates the content of the abstract
 - Author: Full name, academic degree(s), and professional affiliation(s)
 - Abstract text:
 - Background: The problem under investigation or a hypothesis
 - Methods: The methods and materials used to conduct the research
 - Results: The essential results obtained in summary form
 - Conclusions: A summary of research findings supported by the results
- All selected posters must be sized 36"x44" (<u>See Examples & Tips from Duquesne University's Gumberg Library</u>)
- All selected poster presenters (one minimum/poster) must attend in person to present the research during designated times throughout the symposium.
