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

SUBJECT: NC State University Emergency Operations Plan

NC State University has developed an Emergency Operations Plan to facilitate the coordination of activities during the management of an emergency or disaster to protect the people, property, and restore the primary mission of the University. The goal of the Plan is to provide an overview of the organizational structure and function that is in place to manage all types of large-scale emergencies. This Plan also enumerates the roles, responsibilities, and delegated authority of key personnel. Plan recipients should make note of their obligations and accountability in support of this plan. Coordination, cooperation and an understanding of Plan participatory roles is key to restoring campus operations after a declared emergency.

The Environmental Health and Public Safety Division will maintain the NC State University Emergency Operations Plan and coordinate the implementation of associated preparedness activities for the University.
