Take all your documents to the District Court Clerk's Office on the third floor at the Regional Justice Center, 200 Lewis Avenue, in downtown Las Vegas, for filing.		
Prepare your documents for service.		
Gather your file-stamped documents. If you <u>did not</u> file a fee waiver, the clerk will file the documents in front of you and return certain documents to you, and you will move on to the next step. If you <u>did</u> file a fee waiver, you will have to wait a few days to see if the judge approves it. If the judge approves the fee waiver, you will have to go back to the clerk's office to pick up your file-stamped order waiving fees before you can move on to the next steps. If the judge does not approve the fee waiver, you can still move on to the next steps, but you will have to pay the fees.
