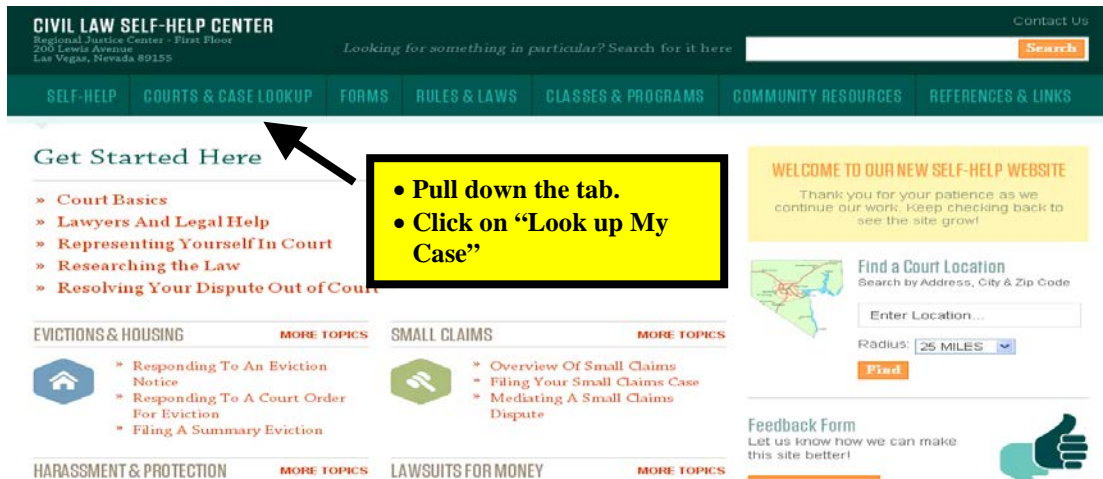


HOW TO LOOK UP YOUR CASE ON THE CIVIL LAW SELF-HELP CENTER WEBSITE

(District Court and Las Vegas Justice Court)

- 1) Go to <http://www.civillawselfhelpcenter.org/>
- 2) From the tabs along the top of the home page, click on “Courts & Case Lookup” and select “Look Up My Case” from the drop-down menu.



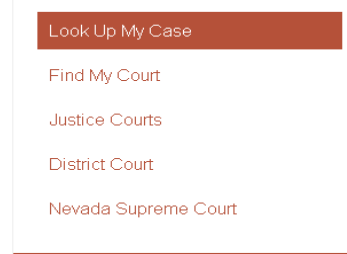
- 3) Click on “Las Vegas Justice Court” or “Eighth Judicial District Court,” depending on where your case was filed.

To look up your court case, click on the name of the court below where your case is pending and follow the steps on that court's website:

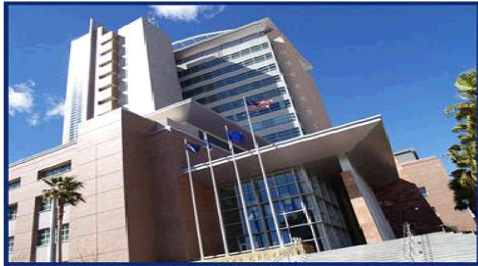

- Click on the court where your case was filed.

- 4) If your case is in the Las Vegas Justice Court, click on “Justice Civil Records.” If your case is in the district court, click the next choice, “District Civil/Criminal records.”



Family Cases, District Court Civil/Criminal Cases, and LV Justice Court Civil Cases are available on this site. Las Vegas Justice Court updated within 3-4 weeks from the hearing date. Traffic School information is available by calling 702-438-3333.



- Click on the court where your case is located.
- If your case is in the justice court, click “Justice Civil Records.”
- If your case is in the district court, click “District Civil/Criminal Records.”

- 5) If you know your case number, enter it where indicated and click “Search.”

If you change the search box to “party,” you can enter the last name and first name of the person you’re looking for. Click “Search” and you’ll get a list of all cases involving someone with that name.

The most recent cases are listed last. Click on a case number and you’ll see everything that has happened in that case.

Sort By: Filed Date

- Pull down the “Search by” tab and choose a search option.
- You can search by case number or by party name.

- If you’re not sure of a name’s spelling, check the “soundex” box.
- When you enter a name and click “Search,” you’ll retrieve cases with names that sound like the one you entered.
