א	Aleph – Silent	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Looks like an X, cancels out sound</li> </ul>
ב	Bet – B	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Has a <b>b</b>elly <b>b</b>utton</li> </ul>
ו	Vet - V	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>V</b>acant or <b>v</b>acuumed out – nothing in the middle</li> </ul>
ג	Gimel - G	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Looks like a runner about to start a race, 3, 2 1, <b>G</b>o!</li> <li>Has little legs which <b>g</b>o!</li> </ul>
ד	Dalet – D	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>D</b>alet is <b>d</b>ented</li> <li><b>D</b>iving board</li> </ul>
ה	Hey - H	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Torn in <b>h</b>alf on one of the sides</li> </ul>
ו	Vav - V	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>V</b>ertical line</li> </ul>
ז	Zayin - Z	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Z</b>ig zag</li> </ul>
ח	Chet - Ch	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Looks like a <b>h</b>ouse or <b>h</b>ut</li> </ul>
ט	Tet – T	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Open or <b>t</b>orn on the <b>t</b>op</li> </ul>
י	Yud - Y	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Yud is the smallest letter, just like the <b>y</b>oungest in the family</li> </ul>
כ	Kaf - K	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Has a cough/kaf drop in its mouth</li> </ul>
כ	Chaf -Ch	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Does not have a cough drop and so it has a lot of phlegm in its throat</li> </ul>
ך	Final Chaf – Ch	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Almost all final letters look like their non-final counterpart if you bend up the long tail</li> </ul>
ל	Lamed – L	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Looks like a <b>l</b>ightning bolt</li> </ul>
מ	Mem – M	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Looks like a <b>m</b>ountain (with a <b>m</b>an climbing)</li> </ul>
ם	Final Mem - M	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Shaped like a <b>m</b>arshmallow</li> </ul>
נ	Nun - N	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Looks like a door <b>n</b>ob / handle</li> </ul>
ן	Final Nun - N	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Almost all final letters look like their non-final counterpart if you bend up the long tail</li> </ul>
ס	Samech - S	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Shaped like a circle, if you draw a line on top looks like a <b>s</b>ailboat</li> </ul>
ע	Ayin - Silent	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Looks like a “y” and when you <b>y</b>awn, you can’t talk</li> </ul>
פ	Pay – P	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Has a <b>p</b>imple</li> <li>Has a <b>p</b>enny in <b>p</b>ocket</li> </ul>
ף	Fay – F	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The penny <b>f</b>ell out of its pocket</li> <li>Looks like a <b>f</b>ace</li> </ul>
ף	Final Fay – F	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Almost all final letters look like their non-final counterpart if you bend up the long tail</li> </ul>
צ	Tzadee – TZ	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Looks like slices of <b>p</b>izza</li> </ul>
ץ	Final Tzadee – TZ	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Almost all final letters look like their non-final counterpart if you bend up the long tail</li> </ul>
ק	Kuf – K	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Looks like the legs of a dancer about to <b>k</b>ick</li> <li>Poof it’s a Koof!</li> </ul>

ר	Resh – R	• Resh is <u>r</u> ounded
ש	Shin – SH	
שׂ	Sin – S	• The dot of A SIN IS NEVER on the RIGHT
ת	Tav - T	• Has a <u>t</u> oe
