G'vurot

G'vurot is the second blessing of the Amidah (a group of blessings at the heart of every prayer service) and comes immediately after Avot V'Imot.

G'vurot comes from the Hebrew word meaning powers.

In this blessing we praise God's awesome powers. These powers are evidence of God's greatness - the same greatness that gives us life and strength to make the world a better place.

You are forever powerful, Adonai, abundant in your saving acts.

You send down the dew (in summer – Passover until Sukkot)

You cause the wind to blow and the rain to fall (in winter – Sukkot until Passover)
In loyalty you sustain the living, nurturing the life of every living thing,
upholding those who fall, healing the sick, freeing the captive and remaining faithful to
all life on earth.

Who can compare to you, Adonai, who can resemble you, the source of everything?

Faithful are you in giving life to every living thing. Blessed are you, Adonai, who gives and renews everything.
