Fever, headache, chills, anorexia, jaundice, hypertension

Blood smear:
P. vivax positive and negative for *P. falciparum*

Treatment

Chloroquine

Additionally, impairment of intra-uterine growth and FETAL LOSS

Diagnosis

Blood Smear: Plasmodial absence
Nested-PCR placental tissue:
Positive for *P. falciparum* and *P. vivax*
Nested-PCR peripheral blood:
Negative for *P. falciparum* and *P. vivax*

Diagnosis

Blood Smear: negative for *P. falciparum* and *P. vivax*
Nested-PCR peripheral blood: Positive for *P. falciparum* only
