

PROBATION SERVICES

The purpose of Probation and Community Intervention Services is to increase public safety by reducing juvenile delinquency through effective intervention and case management services to youth on diversion, probation, and post-commitment supervision. Probation and Community Intervention promotes accountability using restorative sanctions and treatment services that strengthen families and help support youth in becoming responsible citizens.

During FY 2017-18, more than 45,000 youth were served by Probation and Community Intervention programs.

Services described in this chapter are those provided to youth after adjudication is rendered or deferred. Probation intake services are described in the Delinquency Intake chapter.

Diversion services are non-judicial alternatives used to keep less serious offenders from being processed through the traditional juvenile justice system. These services are intended to intervene at an early stage of delinquency, decrease subsequent offenses during and after participation in the programs, and provide for an array of services to youth. These services can range from programs such as teen courts and other contracted diversion programs.

Probation supervision is ordered by the court in cases involving a youth who has been determined to have committed a delinquent act. While on probation, the youth's activities are restricted as the court directs. In many cases, youth are required to participate in services targeting identified needs and risk factors as a condition of their probation. Juvenile probation officers (JPO) are employees of the Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ) who serve as the primary case manager for the purpose of managing, coordinating, and monitoring the services provided and sanctions required for each youth.

In addition to case management services, the JPO is responsible for the intake of youth upon arrest. Intake services begin when the youth or the youth's case paperwork is delivered to the Department. Services provided by JPOs at intake include: a delinquency history records search, screening for detention placement, a suicide risk assessment, a risk and needs assessment, and a mental health and substance-abuse screening. After this initial contact with the youth, the JPO must interview the youth, his or her parents, the arresting officer, the victim(s), and other parties in order to make a recommendation to the state attorney regarding the most appropriate handling of the case.

Juvenile probation officers have two main functions: intake services and supervision of youth.

The Positive Achievement Change Tool (PACT) assessment instrument is used by the JPO to assess a youth's needs and risk to public safety. The most appropriate level of probation supervision is determined based on

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risk factors statistically validated to predict risk to re-offend, including criminal history and the current offense. A reassessment instrument is completed every 90 days or sooner if a change in supervision is needed because of a new law violation or if the youth's degree of compliance changes. The frequency of intervention with the youth is based on the youth's level of risk to re-offend as determined by the PACT assessment, the youth's compliance with court-ordered sanctions, and participation in treatment. During Fiscal Year (FY) 2017-18, more than 116,000 PACT assessments were conducted.

The Positive Achievement Change Tool is used by the JPO to assess a youth's needs and risk to public safety.

For youth on probation, a Youth Empowered Success (YES) Plan is developed and serves as the primary planning tool for the administration and organization of case management services. The YES Plan describes the action steps and target dates for completion of all goals and court-ordered sanctions required to earn a recommendation for termination from supervision. While the youth is under the supervision of the

Department on probation, conditional release, or post-commitment probation, the JPO will make contact (e.g., face-to-face, telephone, review of written reports) with the youth, family, law enforcement, and service providers to ensure compliance with the court order as well as YES Plan goals and sanctions. Violations of probation include new law violations and non-law or technical violations, such as chronic truancy or refusal to attend a day treatment program. When violations occur, the JPO may file an affidavit of violation of probation with the state attorney who will decide whether to petition the court for a hearing. The court approves the final termination from probation.

Youth placed in residential commitment programs are assigned a JPO who will assist the parent(s)/guardian(s) and program staff, as necessary, to ensure coordination and planning for the youth's successful completion of the program. Planning for the youth's transition back into the community begins at the commitment conference when appropriate post-commitment services are identified. Successful transition involves the ongoing efforts on the part of the youth, parent(s)/guardian(s), treatment team, and JPO. Prior to the youth's release from residential care, the program will conduct a transition conference to finalize plans for the youth's release. It is at this time that the JPO will make post-residential service referrals, if indicated. Often, contracted vendors provide and oversee post-release transition services.

Probation day treatment programs are facility-based and target youth on probation in need of a higher level of supervision and service. Day treatment programs provide or oversee delinquency interventions, recreation, vocational, and educational services. Weekends are used for structured activities and mentoring opportunities. Services also include life skills training and outings that offer youth the opportunity to apply life skills in the community. In addition, individual, family, and small group counseling may be provided. JPOs and program case managers monitor progress of the youth at home, school, and work, as well as the youths' compliance with court sanctions. All day treatment programs are operated by DJJ contracted providers.

Post-commitment services are provided to youth released from residential commitment programs. These programs assist with transitioning youth back into their homes and communities. Youth can either be placed

on conditional release or post-commitment probation status. Types of services include day treatment services, contracted community supervision services, state-operated community supervision services, and vocational training.

Day treatment programs for youth on post-commitment supervision are similar to those serving youth at the front end of the system. Activities include counseling, recreation, and community service projects. Community supervision services involve a JPO and the case manager from the day treatment program monitoring the youth's progress at home, school, or work and compliance with other sanctions (curfew, community service, and restitution). Although length of supervision varies, most programs are designed to last three to seven months.

Post-commitment probation (PCP) is a statutorily defined probationary status for juveniles released from DJJ custody but over whom the juvenile court has retained jurisdiction. Similar to probation, the objectives of PCP are to monitor behavior, direct juveniles to community services appropriate to their needs, and aid juveniles in recognizing alternatives to crime. The court must approve termination from PCP. There are some post-commitment residential programs listed in this report. These programs were contracted through Probation and Community Intervention to provide additional services and post-release support for youth returning from a residential commitment program.

A key component of the Department's transformation of the juvenile justice service continuum is increasing transition services via additional contracted, community-based transition services. Services such as vocational and educational assistance, transitional housing, transportation assistance, and mentoring services are being expanded to combat Florida's high post-commitment recidivism rate.

Redirection was established by the Florida Legislature to use community-based alternatives in lieu of residential commitment for those youth that meet certain criteria. Redirection is an alternative option that can be used by JPOs as a sanction for lack of compliance with the YES Plan. The Redirection program is offered in all of Florida's twenty judicial circuits and allows the youth and their family to participate in community-based therapy instead of the youth being placed in a residential facility. During FY 2016-17, youth in all circuits were served in Redirections. Youth on post-commitment supervision are at the highest risk of being re-committed and therefore, Redirection services are offered to this population as well. Due to the difference in risk level of a probation youth vs. an aftercare youth, the outcomes for Redirection programs will be reported separately.

Multi-systemic therapy (MST) services consist of intensive family and community-based treatment that addresses the multiple determinants of serious antisocial behavior in juveniles. This multi-systemic approach views individuals as being nested within a complex network of interconnected systems that encompass individual, family, and extra-familial (peer, school, neighborhood) factors. Intervention may be necessary in any one, or a combination of, these systems. MST services target chronic or substance abusing youth and their families at high risk of out-of-home placement. The major goals of MST are to empower parents with the skills

and resources needed to independently address the difficulties that arise in raising teenagers, and to empower youth to cope with family, peer, school, and neighborhood problems.

Functional Family Therapy (FFT) is an empirically grounded and well documented family intervention program for troubled youth. FFT is applied to a wide range of youth and their families in various multiethnic and multicultural contexts. On average, interventions range from 8 to 12 one-hour sessions for mild cases and up to 30 sessions of direct service for more difficult situations, with sessions spread over a three-month period. FFT is conducted both in clinical settings as an outpatient therapy and as a home-based model.

Probation enhancement services (PES) are additional services a child under the Department’s supervision may be referred to as an overlay service in addition to standard supervision. When in a PES placement, the child is also simultaneously either in a probation, post-commitment probation, probation day treatment, or conditional release status. These services may include mental health counseling, substance abuse counseling, mentoring, career and education enhancement activities, parent and youth support groups/counseling, and respite services. These placements often consist of short-term programs that target a youth’s specific needs. The youth’s JPO continues to monitor progress while he or she participates in PES.

Profile of Youth

The following tables provide demographic data taken from DJJ’s Juvenile Justice Information System (JJIS). Profile data are based on the number of youth, unduplicated, who were provided Probation and Community Intervention services during FY 2017-18.

Outcome Evaluation Performance

The following table shows the Probation and Community Intervention (PCI) Program Profile Summaries and Outcomes, which includes total releases, the percentage of youth adjudicated for any offenses committed during supervision (ODS), number of completions, completion rates, demographic characteristics, average length of stay, and recidivism rates. Program Profile Summaries and Outcomes are based on the number of youth released from a PCI program in FY 2016-17. Data are presented so that it is possible to track recidivism (defined as delinquent or criminal referrals/arrests that resulted in a juvenile adjudication or conviction) for one year from program completion.

During FY 2016-17, there was a total of 31,267 releases and 21,934 completions from the PCI program area. The rates of any offense during supervision ranged from a high of 50% of the releases from provider-operated probation to a low of 6% from diversion services. Completion rates varied from a high of 78% for Probation Enhancement Services to a low of 50% from provider-operated probation.

Given that PCI programs serve a wide variety of youth, from those with no prior offense history to those who have been committed, the substantial differences in the average prior seriousness indices observed across the program areas are as expected. Youth completing diversion programs had the least serious delinquency histories, while youth who were previously committed and who participated in post-commitment services had the most serious delinquency histories. Youth completing intensive programs such as day treatment and Redirection had more serious histories than youth completing general state-operated probation.
