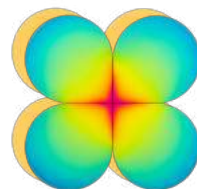

The latest boutique hotel to open in Paris, this space designed by Raphael Navot takes its chic location into its design. Texture is king in every room.



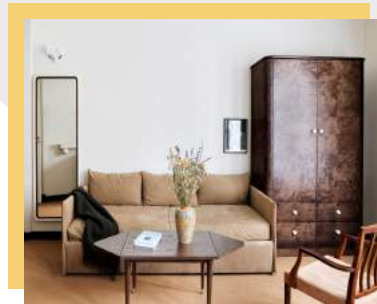
Maison La Roche
