TO CONCLUDE

It was a year for classics, with established names like [Louise Bourgeois](#) and [Gustav Klimt](#) breaking records, but also in the mysterious reemergence of Rembrandt's forgotten [portraits](#). The pair fetched nearly 40% more than their highest estimate at auction. The year closed with [Art Basel Miami Beach](#) securing several seven-digit sales, setting a tone of optimism for 2024.

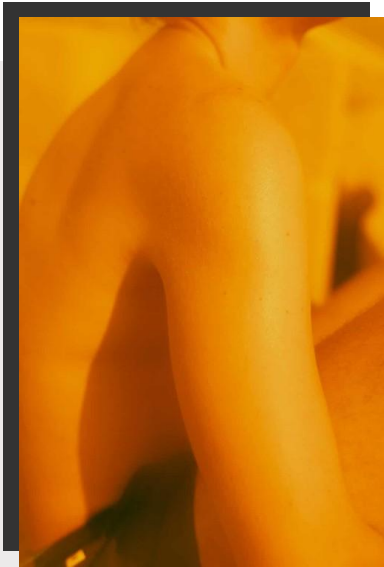

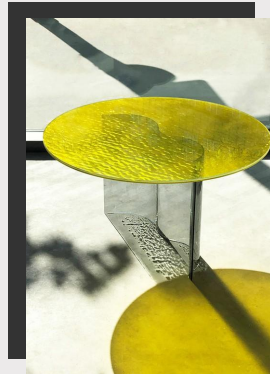

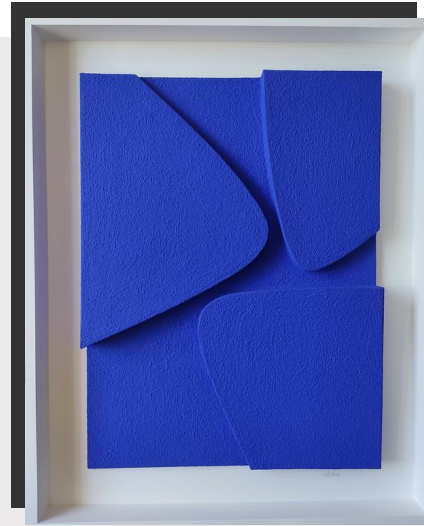

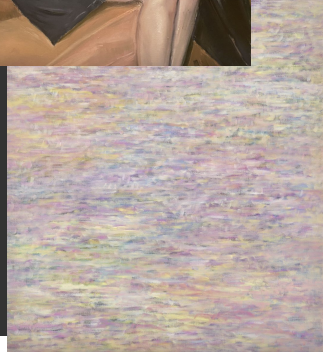
