COVID-19 DATES BY COUNTY FOR BOTTLE BILL REDEMPTION RETURN

WHEN ARE STORES REQUIRED TO ACCEPT BEVERAGE CONTAINERS?

The following chart provides stores and customers specific requirements based on an Oregon county's risk category for accepting redeemable beverage container returns, and the hours stores must accept them.

If a county does not have a date listed next to it in the chart below, the OLCC is not enforcing the requirement that stores in that county accept container returns. When the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) designates a county as Low Risk or Moderate Risk, all stores in that county are required to accept container returns within 5 days of the change in risk designation by OHA.
