SYNOPSIS

The setting of the play is pre-independence Lucknow, where Kachanak is set against the backdrop of some middle-class Muslim families. As soon as the curtain opens, Nao Baglaul Saheb's house is seen where the ceremony of fixing the marriage of Dr. Bukhara's son Ladle Mian with his daughter Gulnar is being performed. Just then a servant named Gulfam comes there and Baglaul. Tells Saheb that Javed Saheb has come from Hyderabad and he wants to meet him. Hearing this, Baglaul Saheb becomes shocked and upset. Because earlier Bagleel Saheb had fixed the marriage of his daughter Gulnar with Javed Mian. But Javed Mian's oneAfter hearing the news of death in the accident, he fixes Gulnar's marriage with Ladle Mian. It is from here that a whirlwind of strange situations begins, which stops only at the end of the play. In fact, the person who visited Baglaul Saheb's place is not Javed Mian, but his sister Shabnam in disguise. In reality, Javed Mian dies after a fight with Shabnam's lover Arif Mian and Arif Mian thinks that Shabnam's brother has been killed by his hands and he runs away to Lucknow. Shabnam also comes to Lucknow in male guise and taking the name of her late brother Javed, to reveal the truth to her lover. Coincidentally, her lover Arif is also staying in the inn where she stays in Lucknow. But both of them are unable to know about each other's stay there. Meanwhile, the servant Gulfam, in order to earn more, gets the job of both of them. But while trying to serve both the masters, he ends up becoming such a dizzy person that he keeps making mistakes one after the other. His owners have to suffer the consequences of his mistakes. The characters trapped in difficult situations due to his mistakes become the laughing stock of the people

The Play 'Jeena isi ka naam hai' is inspired from Arbuzov's original Russian play 'Do you Sommersault' Sarita Sharma is at a sea side health centre to recoup and rejuvenate but according to Dr. Bhullar, the head of the centre, there is hardly anything wrong with her physically. Her unpredictable ways, funny ideas and impulsive action have completely upturned his familiar, orderly world. No wonder then that the story is a "happy ever after one." It does not mope, pine or despair, but revels in the new vistas that old age holds.
