## Miscellaneous

- <u>Accountability</u> The handout contains a quick reference guide with the data source and availability date for the measures. The 2016 reports are available on NWRDC. Selection criteria available upon request.

The data collection and reporting functionality has been split into two areas PK-20 Education Reporting and Accessibility (**PERA**) remains under the Division of Accountability Research & Measurement while CCTCMIS and Bureau of PK-12 Education Information Services (EIS) will move to the Division of Technology & Innovation Information. CCTCMIS will now focus on data quality/integrity, timely submissions, and integration of new technology.

- Data Submissions 2017-18: Contact college leads (FLEID submission) to set-up for multiple access or batch up load process for data submission and other file transfers. Testing in the current year, however all data submissions and other file transfers will be done through this new process in 2017-18.
- Historical Reports on NWRDC: Download and store historical reports locally. These will not be maintained on the new system (TIBCO).

# • Perkins - Presentation

The data used for Perkins allocation and measures are different. The allocation of Perkins funds uses data identifying need based (Student Database Data Element 3102) with FETPIP matching of enrolled students. The performance measures use the following vocational programs (Student Database Element DE 2005) such as AS, AAS, and certificates (Lower Division College Credit, Public Safety Academies) and Applied Technology Diplomas. Funding is not directly tied to the performance measures.

### Florida Education Identifier (FLEID) – Presentation

• Presentation outlines assignment flow, recent/upcoming enhancements (Pre-Processing File vs E-mail, Process Automation, Duplicate Restrictions, Verification & Validation), and other updates.

# IPEDS - Handout

- **Dun and Bradstreet Data Universal Number system (D-U-N-S):** There is a one-time request to provide one or more numbers. This will facilitate the use of IPEDs data in the grants system with the goal of improving data sharing within the agency and decreasing duplicative reporting by institutions.
- <u>Graduation Rate Survey:</u> Pell Grants and Subsidized Stafford Loan information will be included as part of the 2016-17 reporting year. These data will be pulled from the SDB Record Type 8/ Financial Aid, Data Element 3208/Financial Aid Award Type.

• Five new edits were added for 2016-17 to clarify which databases are loaded.

# Personnel Database (PDB) - Handout

• Informational edits were added for Course Start Date (DE4005) and Couse End Date (DE4010). These edits will become critical in 2017-18.

- AGE Course Exit Date (DE 3027) replaces Course Exit Date (DE 3024) beginning the 2017-18 Summer (1E) submission

# The following data elements are actively used by SPC:

- Entry Level/Exit Test Score (DE 1101): New score ranges were added (10-40) for all disciplines. The SAT2016 Math test is reported in increments of 0.5 and reported right-justified with leading zeros and an implied decimal (e.g., 20.5 reported as 0205). The file position for this data element will change from 24-27 to 50-55.
- Entry Level/Exit Test Type (DE 1104): New table value is U (SAT2016). Table values FCAT (D) and SAT (S) will be deleted beginning the 2017-18 Summer (1E) submission.
- Entry Level/Exit Test Date (DE 1105): March 2016 is the earliest data reportable for SAT2016. Edit number 9 was changed from critical to informational. Edit number 5 was eliminated.
- Completion Date (DE 2102): This data element will be deleted beginning the 2017-18 Summer (1E) submission and replaced with AGE Completion Date (DE2121) to accommodate for eight digit dates (MMDDCCYY).
