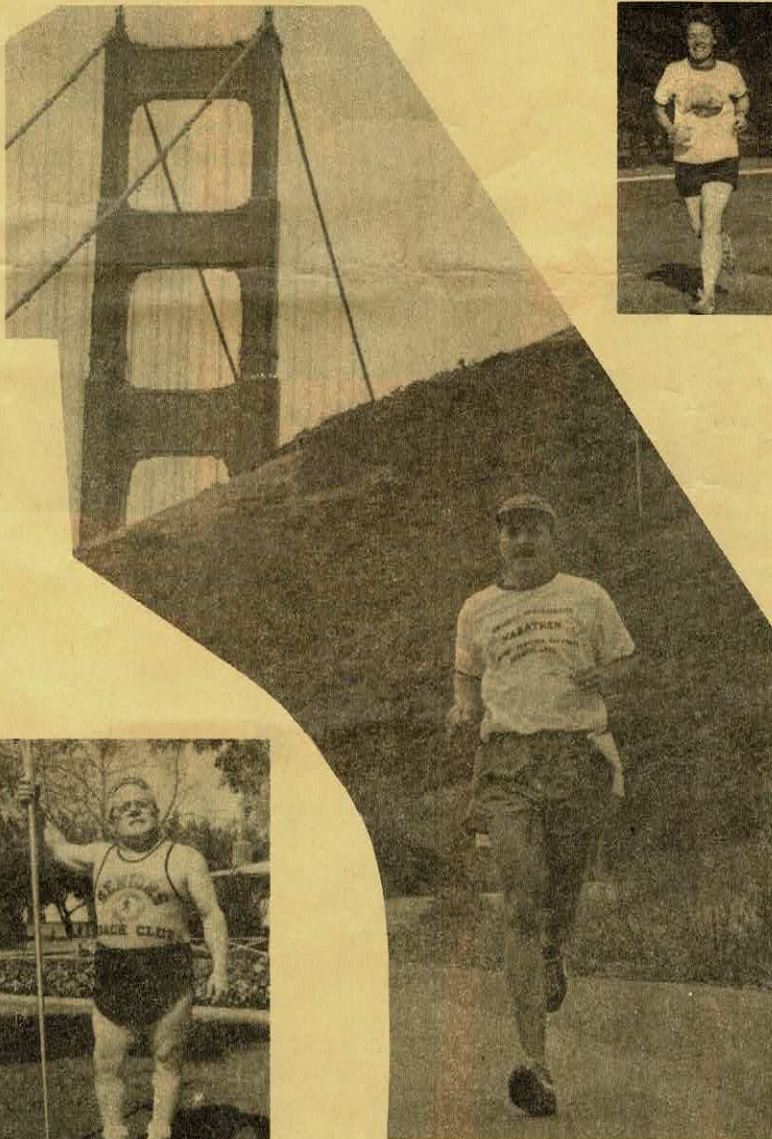

This year will probably be remembered as the year that the Masters Track & Field Program really came of age. On the international level, the first World Championships will be held in August in Toronto, Canada. In the U.S., with Bob Fine as Chairman of the National Masters Subcommittee, organization has come upon the scene with the country being divided into regions - each with its own championship meet.

Our region is the Western Region, and this founding meet is our first region championship. The Western Region includes California, Arizona, Nevada, Hawaii, and Guam. It is a fact that this region can count the preponderant share of national champions and record holders among its residents. Thus, it follows that this meet will be second only to the national championships in significance within the U.S.

This meeting is also the first championship meet with a complete Submasters schedule of events. It is also the first that truly treats women as equals in Masters competition, with an impressive slate of events and open registration in three age classes (30-39, 40-49, and 50 and over).

This is also the first Masters championship meet held in northern California. Many fellow members of the northern California Seniors Track Club have stepped forward to volunteer their services to help make it a success, and I want to thank them for their efforts. Bill Monheit has assumed the responsibility for arranging all of the accommodations at U.S. Berkeley, including lodging, meals, reception, banquet, and warm-up track, as well as the helpful participation by the City of Oakland and the Oakland Tribune. He deserves a special "thank you" from us all. The Esalen Institute has joined the above organizations in making significant contributions. By meet time, there doubtless will be others and we will try to let you know who they are at that time. We also want to thank the various meet officials who are helping make this a successful meet.

Welcome to you all - competitors and spectators alike. The comraderie that you will experience is what makes the Masters Program; good luck this week-end.

Awards: A commemorative patch will be awarded to each competitor. An "A.A.U. Western Masters Champion" patch will be awarded to each class 1A, 1B, 2A, 2B, 3A, 3B, or 4 winner. Each champion patch winner must be registered with one of the Region's associations (Arizona, California, Nevada, Hawaii, and Guam). If the actual first place winner in any event is registered outside of the region, the the highest placing Western Region-registered competitor will be awarded the champion patch. Classes OA, OB, OW, 1W and 2W may not be awarded any "Masters Champion" patches under existing A.A.U. rules. However, all divisions will have medals for 1st through 3rd places in each event. The medals will be 2-inch diameter with three-color (red, white and blue) neck ribbon and of a quality not seen at Master's events to date. They will feature high quality die work struck on bronze base metal with real gold, old silver, or bronze plating and a three-color (red, white and blue) filled "A.A.U. Western Masters" shield in the center.

NOTE: The official "A.A.U. Western Masters" lapel pins and patches may be purchased for \$3.00 and \$2.00, respectively while stocks last. You may send a check and self-addressed envelope to the Meet Director at any time prior to the meet for this purpose.
