Historic Founders Reunion









medicine providers at all levels. The trip culminated with the trio putting on an AMSSM symposium at the South African Sports Medicine Association Annual Meeting (SASMA).


Fellows Research Conference

AMSSM Launches Sports Ultrasound Online Didactics

cover the didactic instructional sessions outlined in the AMSSM Recommended Sports Ultrasound Curriculum for Sports Medicine Fellowships. Each video provides a concise overview of the relevant topic. Topics are divided into introductory lectures for diagnostic and interventional ultrasound; live video demonstrations of regional diagnostic ultrasound examinations of the shoulder, elbow, wrist-hand, hip, knee as well as elbow; and interventional procedures for each joint. These videos are an exceptional resource for sports medicine fellows and sports medicine physicians new to sports ultrasound.

AMSSM Hires Research Director to Help Launch Collaborative Research Network



After a nation-wide search, Stephanie Kliethermes, PhD was selected to serve as AMSSM's first Research Director. Stephanie led the biostats core at Loyola University in Chicago previously. The University of Wisconsin has been selected to serve as the academic home of the AMSSM Collaborative Research Network (CRN) where Stephanie will be based, beginning in May 2016. She will devote 80 percent of her time to the CRN. The CRN will spawn and facilitate multi-center research within AMSSM to answer key clinical guestions within primary care/non-operative sports medicine.



AMSSM Testifies in Support of Sports Medicine Licensure Clarity Act

In early December, AMSSM, represented by Chad A. Asplund, MD, MPH, Chair of AMSSM's Practice and Policy Committee, testified before the Health Subcommittee of the House Energy and Commerce Committee on HR 921, the Sports Medicine Licensure Clarity Act. Dr. Asplund spoke in support of this important bill that would protect team physicians and athletic trainers when traveling with their teams across state lines. Most states do not

recognize the license of out-of-state medical professionals therefore when a team travels to another state for a game, match or meet, the medical teams in charge of keeping the athletes healthy, safe and on the field put their medical licenses and malpractice insurance at risk.

2016 Collaborative Solutions for Safety in Sport Meeting

The 2016 Collaborative Solutions for Safety in Sport (CSSS) meeting took place at the NCAA Headquarters in Indianapolis, IN, on March 22-23, 2016. For each of the first two years of this meeting co-hosted by AMSSM and the National Athletic Trainers' Association, leaders, decision makers and experts in high school sports from all 50 states gathered together to lay the foundation for a new collaborative approach to education, development and implementation of best practices for safety in high school sports. The 2016 event featured experts in the

fields of heat illnesses, cardiac conditions, head injuries and mental health. They discussed emerging strategies, research and issues for each topic, as well as shared recent successes throughout the country. This year also included two breakout sessions that provided practical tools and tips to address common challenges.

AMSSM Releases Scientific Statement Concerning Viscosupplementation

This winter AMSSM released a scientific statement that provides guidance for physicians and healthcare professionals who provide care for those patients with knee osteoarthritis. The full report, published in the January 2016 issues of Clinical Journal of Sport Medicine (CJSM) and British Journal of Sports Medicine (BJSM), entitled, AMSSM Scientific Statement Concerning Viscosupplementation Injections for Knee Osteoarthritis Importance for Individual Patient Outcomes, includes several notable AMSSM recommendations and one key suggestion.



Dr. Tom Trojian (AMSSM Past Board of Director) served as lead author along with contributors Drs. Susan Joy (AMSSM Foundation Board Member), Andrew Concoff and John Hatzenbuehler as well as Whitney Saulsberry, PharmD and Craig Coleman, PharmD who also served on the expert writing group for the paper.

AMSSM Members Serve as Guest Editors on CJSM/WEM Thematic Issue

The Clinical Journal of Sport Medicine (CJSM) and the Journal of Wilderness & Environmental Medicine (WEM) co-published The Pre-Participation Evaluation of the Wilderness Athlete and Adventurer thematic issue in September 2015. The 13-article issue was the result of a year and half-long collaboration between AMSSM and Wilderness Medical Society (WMS) authors. It followed the general format of the Pre-Participation Evaluation (PPE) and serves as an adjunct or ready



reference for physicians performing evaluations on wilderness athletes and adventurers. AMSSM Member Guest Editors included Drs. Chris Madden (AMSSM Immediate Past President) and Chad Asplund (AMSSM Board of Director). AMSSM Member Dr. Tom Trojian (Past Board of Director) served as the *CJSM* theme issue editor.

AMSSM Collaborates with Jr. NBA

AMSSM formed a partnership with the National Basketball Association to better disseminate AMSSM patient tip sheets and content geared towards the public that is available on the SportsMedToday.com website. The partnership enables the new Jr. NBA website to feature applicable comprehensive sports



medicine tip sheets written and developed by AMSSM experts. Parents, coaches, etc. can register for the Jr. NBA network at JrNBA.com and receive access to these tip sheets and more. The NBA's goal is to reach 6 million youth (and their parents) in the next five years.
