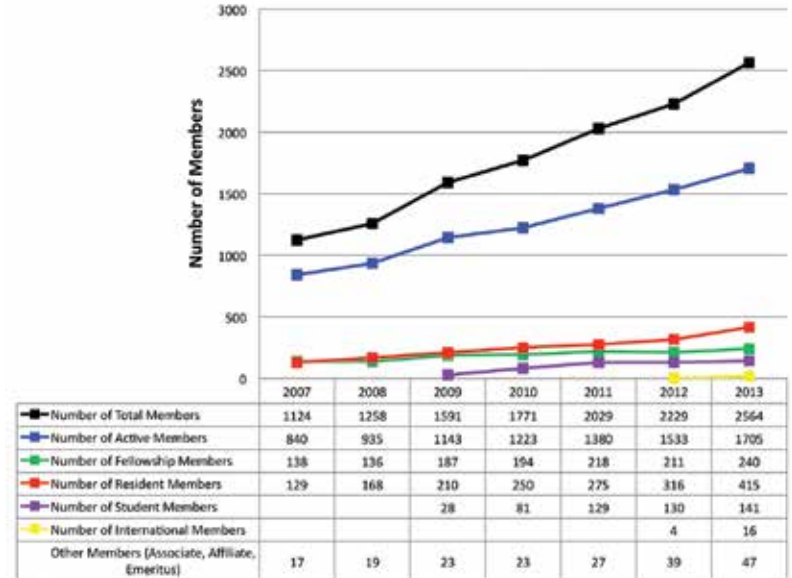

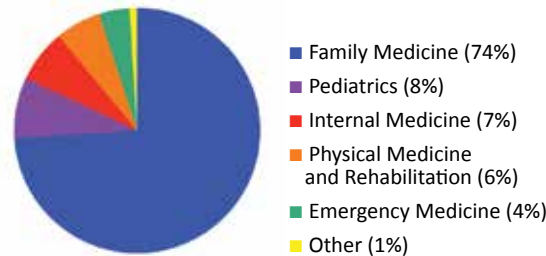

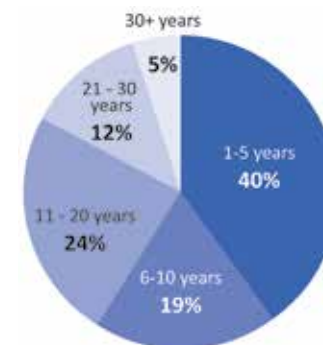
Year-End Membership Trends



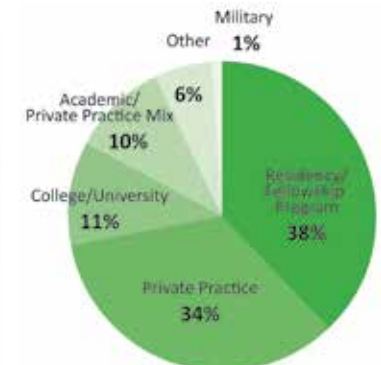
Breakdown by Specialty

Members' Clinical Settings



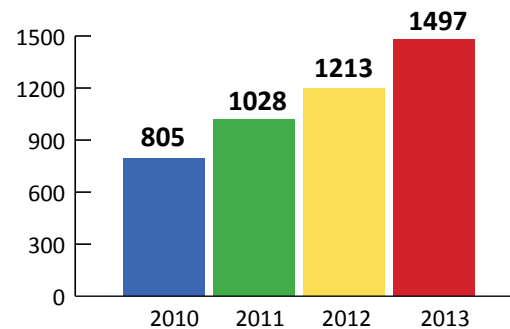

Nearly 1,500 sports medicine physicians from across the US and 10 countries around the world attended the 2013 AMSSM 22nd Annual Meeting in San Diego, CA. The conference featured lectures and research addressing the most challenging topics in sports medicine including prevention of sudden cardiac death, concussion, musculoskeletal ultrasound and more.

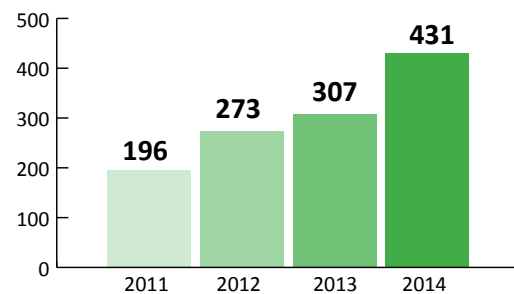


Rebranded as the **Fellows Research and Leadership Conference**, (formerly the Fellows Research Workshop), the conference placed a greater emphasis on developing fellows' leadership skills. Fellows were encouraged to lead by investing in leadership education and experiences. Additionally, the 83 fellows in attendance had an opportunity to meet one-on-one with a faculty mentor to outline their research activities for the upcoming year.

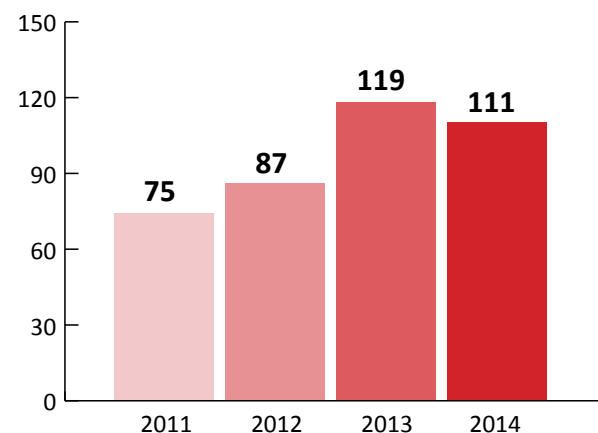

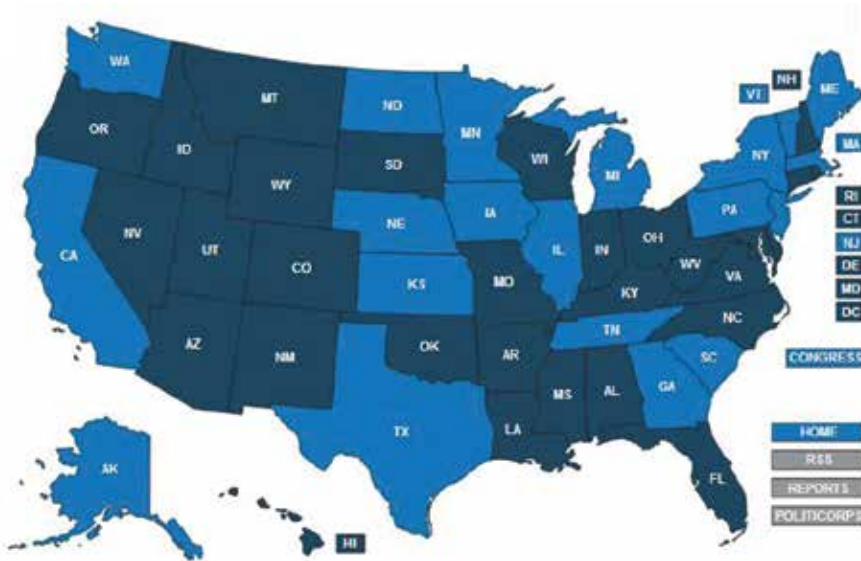

Sports Medicine Legislation Monitored by AMSSM



REAL-TIME MONITORING TOOL TRACKS SPORTS MEDICINE LEGISLATION

New to the Member Area on the AMSSM website in 2013 was an interactive monitoring tool (map pictured above) used to track sports medicine legislation across the U.S. Through AMSSM's ability to filter those bills that may have some applicability to our specialty, AMSSM is able to track applicable bills by state. It is AMSSM's hope that the tool will help encourage increased member participation in legislative activities.



An initiative of the ABIM Foundation

AMSSM became a partner of the *Choosing Wisely*® campaign, an initiative of the ABIM Foundation to release evidence-based lists of tests and procedures that are commonly ordered but not always necessary and could cause harm. AMSSM's Quality Measures Subcommittee is preparing recommendations and anticipates the list of five tests and procedures will be available at the 2014 AMSSM Annual Meeting.



NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF STATE LEGISLATORS

In August, AMSSM was represented at the National Conference of State Legislators Annual Meeting in Atlanta, advocating to state legislators on issues of importance to sports medicine physicians and patients. Drs. Chad Asplund, Chad Carlson (pictured right), Ken Mautner and Brandon Mines (pictured left), as well as Executive Director Jim Griffith attended on behalf of AMSSM. This three-day event was a valuable chance to develop contacts with state representatives across the U.S. The 2014 NCSL meeting will be in Minneapolis, Minnesota.

AMSSM'S PRIMARY GOALS FOR THE 2014 LEGISLATIVE SEASON

- Continued support of state-by-state efforts to promote concussion legislation.
- Efforts to address the loophole that affects team physicians crossing state lines:

On Thursday, December 12, 2013, US House Bill 3722 was filed and sent for review to both the House Judiciary Committee and Energy and Commerce Committee. This bill, which would extend malpractice and other legal protections to sports medicine physicians and certified athletic trainers who are traveling across state lines with their team, was sponsored by Representative Tom Latham (R) of Iowa and co-sponsored by Representative Cedric Richmond (D) of Louisiana. John Thune (R) of South Dakota has agreed to sponsor a Senate version of the bill.

- Efforts to promote educational legislation on commotio cordis that parallel the successful efforts surrounding concussion legislation.

SAFETY IN COLLEGE FOOTBALL SUMMIT

AMSSM participated in this important meeting, January 22, 2014 in Atlanta. Targeted topics for discussion and action included:

- Mitigating concussive and subconcussive impacts in competition and practice
- Independent autonomy and objective decision-making by sport medical providers
- Template for management and return-to-play following concussion.

NATA/AMSSM TASK FORCE ON HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETICS HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICIES:

AMSSM has been asked to join with NATA leaders in a collaborative effort to promote sound practices for this population.

HAITI TRIP: AMSSM Course Equips 300 Medical Professionals with Skills to Advance Athletic Care



In partnership with the Haitian Sports Medicine Society, AMSSM hosted its first Sports Medicine/Sports Trauma and Event Medicine Conference in Port-au-Prince, Haiti on June 29 – July 3, 2013. Designed as a “teach-the-teacher” course, the conference’s intention was to advance the education of professionals in Haiti who care for active people. The project was an AMSSM humanitarian initiative to reach out to sports medicine societies in underserved areas of the world to promote healthy lifestyles and heal people from athletic injuries. Volunteer faculty from AMSSM included Drs. Jean Robert Ferdinand, Christina Hector, Nick Moore, Chuck Peterson, Gracia Pierre-Pierre, Pierre Rouzier and Tom Trojjan.
