

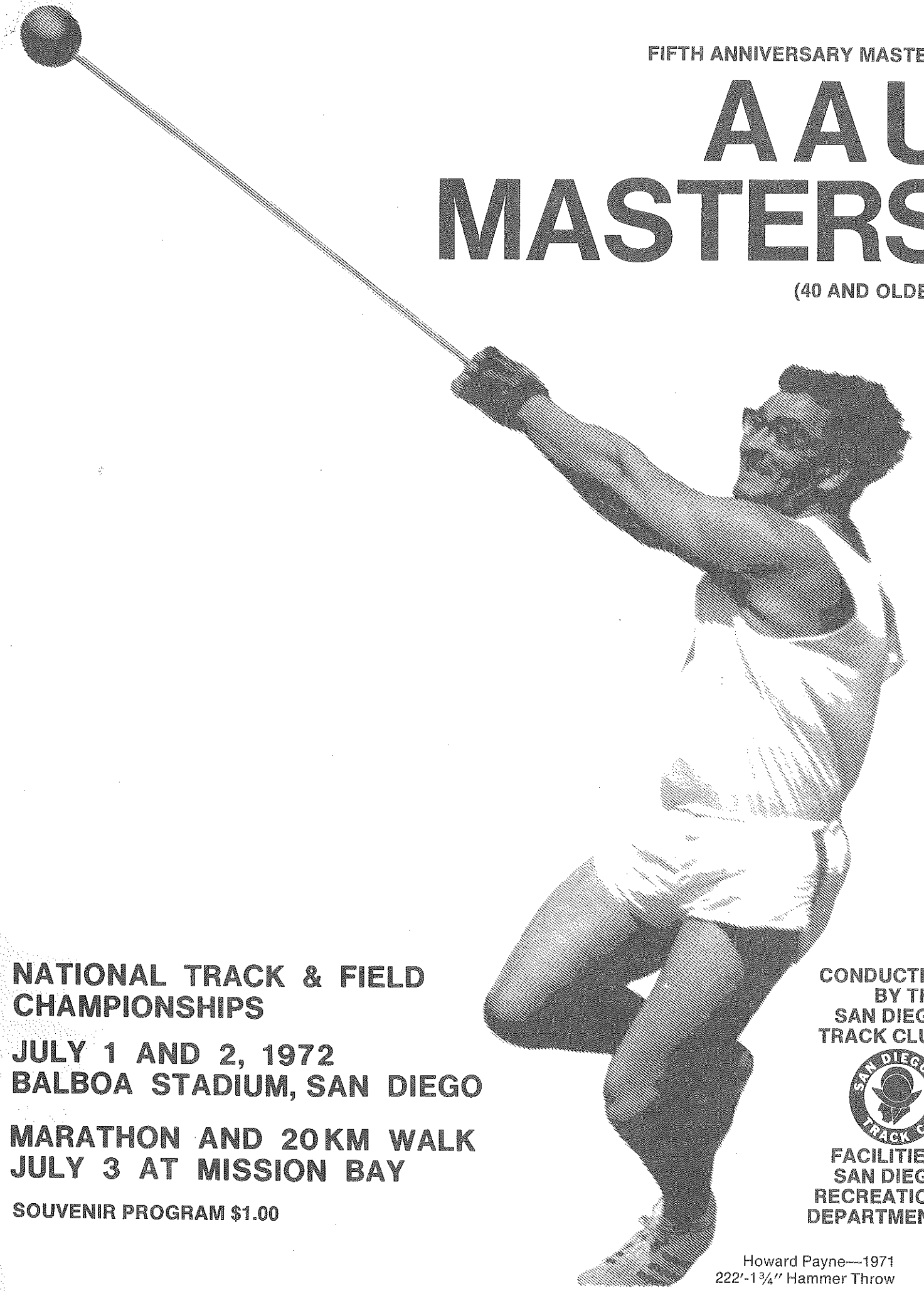

WELCOME TO THE MASTERS!

To those of you who are coming to San Diego for your first Masters, we hope you find the meet comes up to your expectations. To those who are returning, (many for their fifth meet) we trust you continue to find satisfaction in the competition.

The Masters rules have now been incorporated in the A.A.U. Track and Field rules book. They are essentially the same—in Division 1—as those which apply to international competition.

You will note, also, the change to metric distances in this Olympic year. For those of you who are unfamiliar with the comparative metric times, the following are rough equivalents:

100 meters: Add 1.0 second to 100 yds. time
 200 meters: Subtract 0.1 second from 220 yds. time
 400 meters: Subtract 0.3 second from 440 yds. time
 800 meters: Subtract 0.8 second from 880 yds. time
 1,500 meters: Subtract about 15 seconds from 1 mile time
 5,000 meters: Add about 32 seconds to 3 mile time
 10,000 meters: Add about 65 seconds to 6 mile time

This year Bill Stock, the president of the San Diego Track Club will be in charge of the track and field officials at Balboa Stadium, as well as the marathon. Competing, as well, he serves as an example of the many other hard-working people of the San Diego Track Club who make it possible for us to put on meets such as this.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Registration:

Saturday and Sunday, July 1 and 2—from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at the southeast (open) end of Balboa Stadium.

Marathon registration and 20 Kilometer Walk registration is from 6:00 a.m. to 6:35 a.m. on July 3 near the entrance to the Mission Bay Golf Course, west of Interstate 5, north of Clairemont Drive Exit, but Marathon and 20 Kilometer Walk entrants may register at Balboa Stadium on July 1 and 2 at the hours listed above.

You must register at least one hour before the scheduled time of your events at Balboa Stadium and you should report to the Clerk of the Course on the field, toward the north (closed) end of the Stadium at least one-half hour before the event.

Workouts:

The Stadium track and infield will not be available for workouts after 11:00 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday. Please cooperate and confine your workouts to the upper field, to the north and west of the north (closed) end of the stadium. The compressed schedule and greater number of entrants require a clear infield so that officials and athletes can perform efficiently.

Results:

Results will be posted soon after your event on a board in the north (closed) end of the stadium in the lower rows of seats. If you want a complete listing of the results (available 2-3 weeks after the meet) please sign up to receive them at the registration desk. We will make a modest charge of \$1.00 to cover the expenses of producing this extensive compilation.

Awards:

A commemorative patch will be given to each competitor. Special awards will be awarded to the Outstanding Athlete in each age-group Division, with a second award to the "other" category winner within the Division. That is, if a field event man wins the Outstanding Athlete Award in his Division, a track event man will receive the "other" award within that Division. AAU Masters Medals, mounted on marble paperweights will be awarded as follows:

***Running Events:** Div. 1, 2, & 3: 1st through 6th, except 110 H.H., 400 I.H., and 3000 M.S.C., which will have 2 awards in Div. 2, none in Div. 3.
Div. 4: 1st place

***Field Events:** Div. 1, 2, & 3: 1st through 6th, except pole vault & triple jump, which will each have one award each in Division 3.
Div. 4: 1st place

Walks: Div. 1 & 2: 1st through 3rd in 5000, 1 to 6 in 20 K.
Div. 3 & 4: 1st place

Pentathlon (L.J., Jav., 200, Discus, 1500)
Div. 1: 1st thru 6th
Div. 2: 1st through 3rd
Div. 3: 1st place

Relays: Div. 1: 1st through 3rd
Div. 2: 1st & 2nd

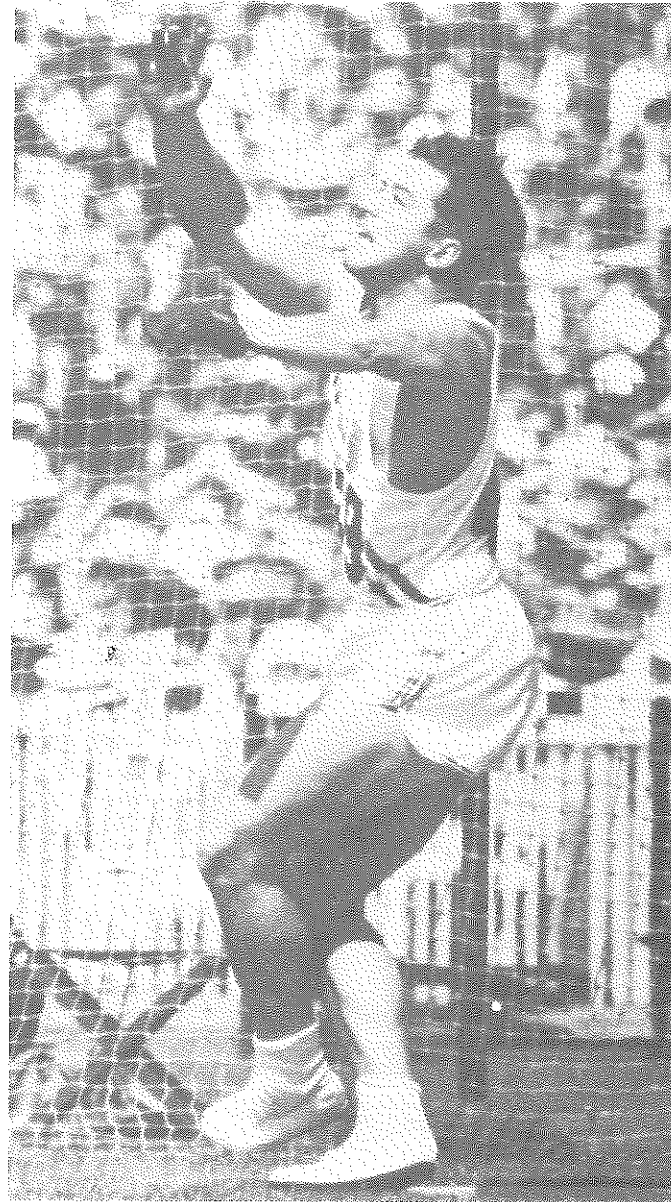

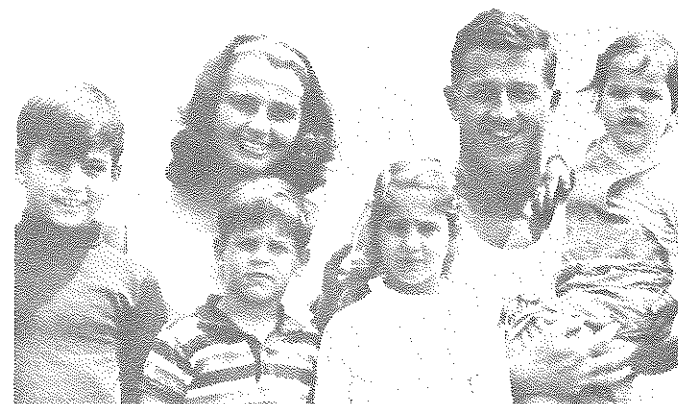
Other awards will include Marathon completion certificates to all finishers, tee shirts for all marathoners, trophies for the oldest athlete and for the one who has traveled the greatest distance, and awards to the first three teams in point scoring. Except for special awards, Marathon & 20 Kilometer Walk awards, and Outstanding Athlete awards, all awards will be presented soon after the finish of the event at Balboa Stadium. The Awards Banquet, which has been an outstanding feature of previous years, will again be held on Sunday, July 3, at 2:00 p.m.

Awards Banquet:

The Awards Banquet (with no-host refreshments available at 1:00 p.m.) will be held this year at the Mission Room of the Bahia Hotel (at 998 West Mission Bay Drive) at 2:00 p.m. on July 3, 1971, on the top floor of the newer building closest to West Mission Bay Drive. Dinner price is \$7 (\$5 for children under 12 years). A limited number of reservations may be made at the registration desk if you have not already done so.

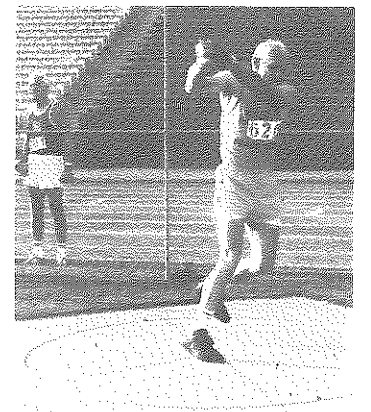

At Melbourne in 1956, where he won the gold medal, he met another gold medal winner, Olga Fikatova, a discus thrower from Czechoslovakia. A romance flourished in spite of cold war difficulties and eventually they were married.

Olga, still in competition, and throwing better than ever with all the children in school, is a near-certainty to make another United States Olympic team. Hal will have a tougher time and the former world record holder can make it again if he equals some of his recent practice throws. Good luck, Hal!

1972 MASTERS MARATHON

We hope you have not been inconvenienced by the last-minute change in the marathon course. The extensive road and bridge construction on the former course, together with increasing traffic congestion have forced the decision to move to this new route.

It has been carefully measured, with AAU certification pending, is as close to being flat as possible, and reduces the dangerous traffic crossings to a minimum. We hope you will do well on it. All competitors have been supplied with maps, but for those who wish to watch, we provide the following:

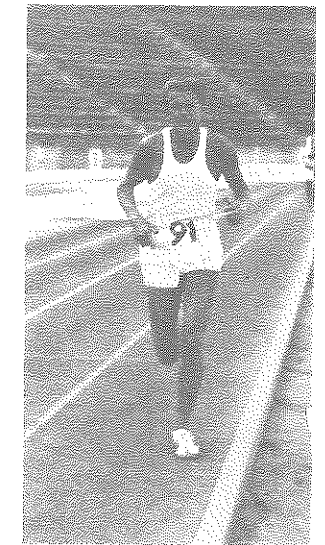
The start and finish is just west of the entrance to the Mission Bay Golf Course in the northeast corner of Mission Bay Park. The course proceeds east, then south along E. Mission Bay Dr. to the causeway onto Fiesta Island. The island is looped in a counter-clockwise direction, back across the causeway, then south and west on a dirt road to Sea World's parking lot. Turn south (left) and cross the parking lot and turn left onto the access road and follow it to Sea World Dr. Turn east (left) onto Sea World Dr. and return to the causeway to Fiesta Island. This section ("Fiesta Island loop" and "Sea World loop") is run 3 times and upon completion of the third lap, the course will return to the start via E. Mission Bay Drive, finishing in the vicinity of the start.

Showers and dressing facilities will be available at Mission Bay High School, 2475 Grand Ave. No towels and bring your own lock. Mission Bay High School is located a short 1/2 mile from the start and finish of the marathon course via the sidewalk at the west end of Mission Bay Golf Course.

If you have containers of liquid you want to pick up at aid stations, label them properly and present them to the Supervisor of aid stations at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the race.

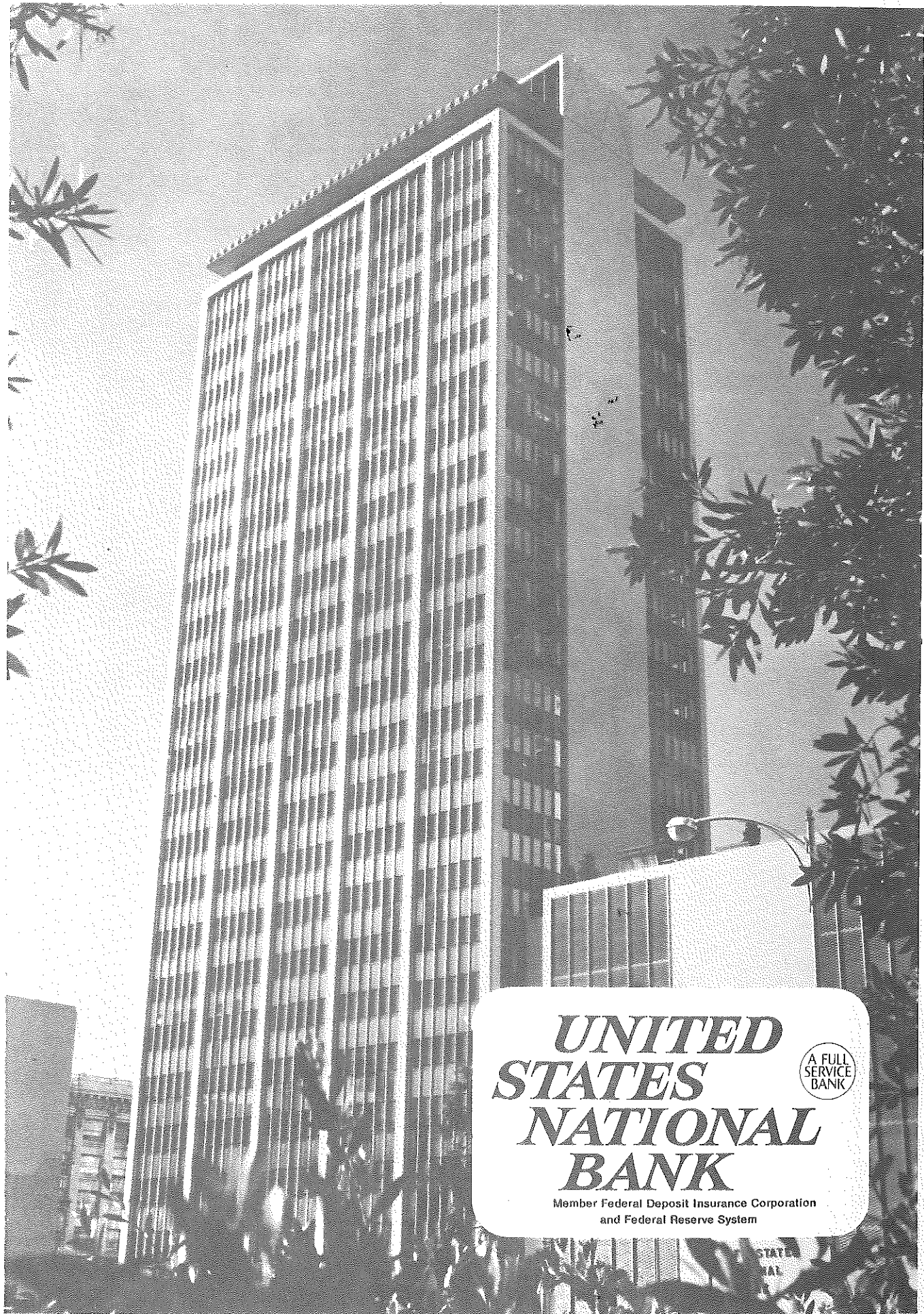

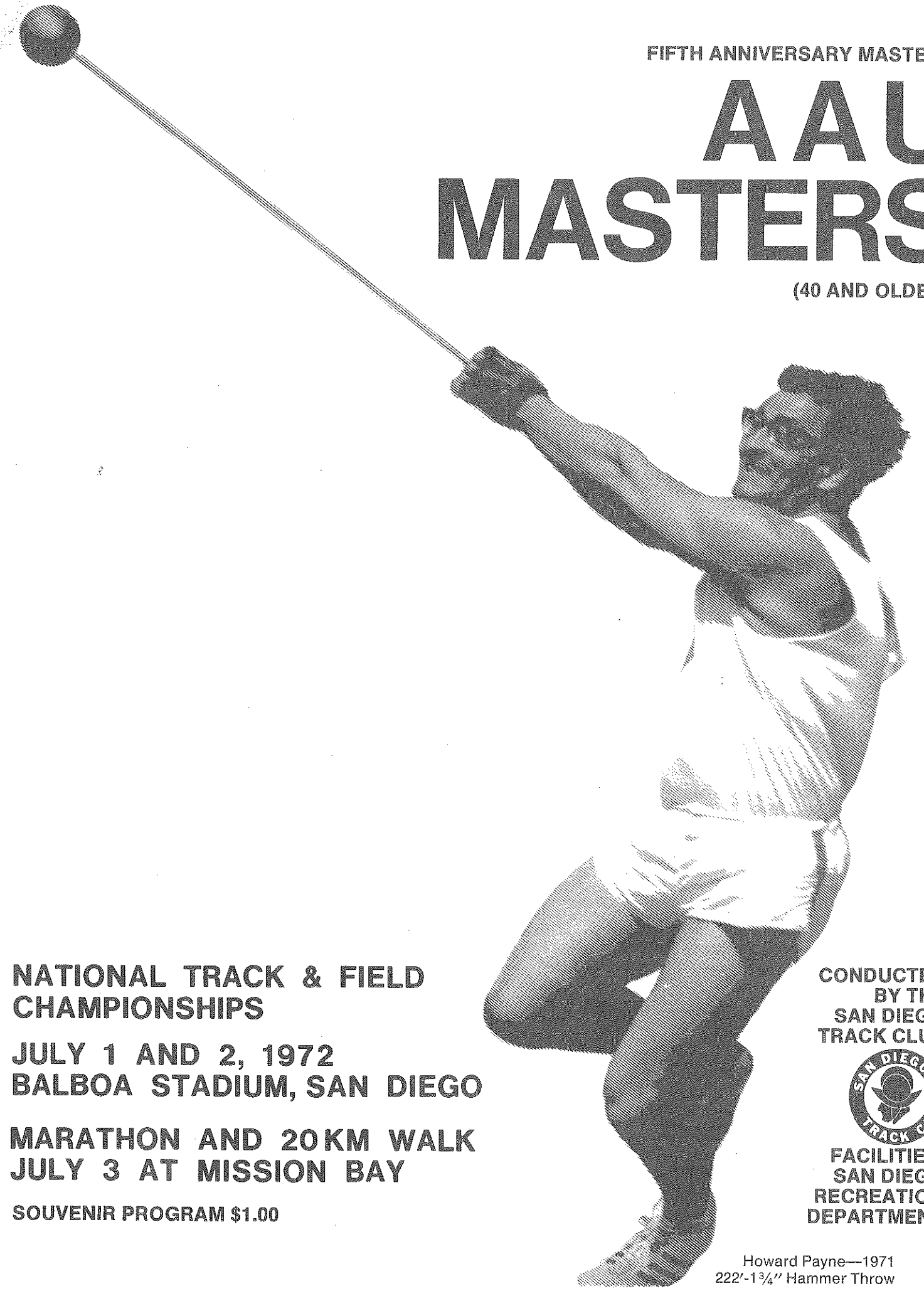
