DFSA

The CDP is also responsible for reviewing the status of least developed countries (LDCs) and for monitoring their progress after graduation from the category.

SUMMARY

The 2015 Country Snapshots compile the key statistical data used by the Committee for Development Policy (CDP) at the 2015 triennial review of the least developed country (LDC) category.

LDCs are defined as low-income countries suffering from structural impediments to sustainable development. To identify LDCs, the CDP uses three criteria: gross national income (GNI) per capita; human assets index (HAI) and economic vulnerability index (EVI). HAI and EVI are indices composed of four and eight indicators, respectively. These twelve indicators, together with the indices for per capita GNI, HAI and EVI, are presented in one-page profiles for each of the 48 countries classified as LDCs in 2015, thus providing a snapshot of each country's situation at the 2015 triennial review. The snapshots also illustrate the gaps in progress towards the LDC graduation thresholds for each country, while comparing individual outcomes with corresponding results for all LDCs and developing countries.

A brief introduction to the LDC category and the inclusion and graduation procedure precedes the country snapshots.





Inclusion from the LDC category

Inclusion eligibility

- ► Inclusion threshold must be met for all three criteria (per capita GNI, HAI, EVI) at one triennial review
- ▶ Population must be less than 75 million inhabitants

Inclusion thresholds (2015 triennial review)

- ▶ Per capita GNI: \$1,035 or above
- ► HAI: 60 or below
- ► EVI: 36 or above

Inclusion procedure

- ▶ DESA formally notifies country of eligibility finding
- ▶ CDP submits inclusion recommendation to the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations (ECOSOC)
- ECOSOC endorses the recommendation by the CDP
- ► Country formally notifies the Secretary-General of its acceptance
- General Assembly takes note of the ECOSOC recommendation
- ► Inclusion takes effect immediately

Graduation from the LDC category

Graduation eligibility

- Graduation threshold must be met for two of the three criteria (per capita GNI, HAI, EVI)
- ► Alternatively, per capita GNI is at least twice the graduation threshold

Graduation thresholds (2015 triennial review)

- ► Per capita GNI: \$1,242 \$2,484 for income only
- ► HAI: 66 and above
- ► EVI: 32 and below

Graduation procedure

- ▶ Eligibility for graduation has to be met at two consecutive triennial reviews
- After country has been found eligible for graduation for the first time, UN/DESA prepares an ex ante impact assessment, and UNCTAD prepares a vulnerability profile of that country as inputs to the CDP decision-making process
- ► Country is invited to present its views on the possibility of graduation at the CDP expert group meeting preceding the next triennial review
- ► CDP recommends the country for graduation on the basis of the LDC criteria and the additional information provided by the country, UN/DESA and UNCTAD
- ▶ ECOSOC endorses the recommendation by the CDP
- ▶ General Assembly takes note of the decision of ECOSOC
- ▶ Graduation takes effect three years after the decision by the General Assembly

Preparation for graduation

- ▶ During the three-year period before graduation is effective, country still belongs to the LDC category and is entitled to receive all benefits available to LDCs
- Country is invited to prepare a transition strategy in cooperation with development partners
- ▶ CDP monitors development progress of the country and the preparation of the transition strategy

Smooth transition from the LDC category

- ▶ After graduation is effective, country no longer belongs to the LDC category
- ▶ LDC-specific support should be phased out gradually and in a predictable manner after graduation
- ► Country implements the transition strategy, supported by development partners
- ▶ CDP monitors development progress of the country and the implementation of the transition strategy for three consecutive years after graduation takes effect, then triennially for two triennial reviews








