



## *Political Culture and Democratic Governance 2006*

### *Technical Information*

This survey was carried out in 2006 at part of the AmericasBarometer. It has a regional perspective so that findings could be compared with a group of Latin American countries. It was conducted by Centro de Información y Recursos para el Desarrollo (CIRD) and the fieldwork was carried out under the direction of Alejandro Vial and Manuel Orrego, with technical suggestions being provided by Latin American Public Opinion Project (LAPOP).

The survey was carried out in the oriental region and was a probability design, with a total N of 1,165. The sample was stratified by area (urban and rural). The interviews were conducted in 220 sampling points and clusters within the sampling points were of 5 respondents each. The sample frame was based on the 2002 Population and Housing census of Paraguay.

The complete sample is composed of 49.7% male respondents and 50.3% female, all of them over 18 years old and its estimated margin of error is  $\pm 3.0$  (at the 95% level).
