The prospectus is now ready and is obtainable on application.



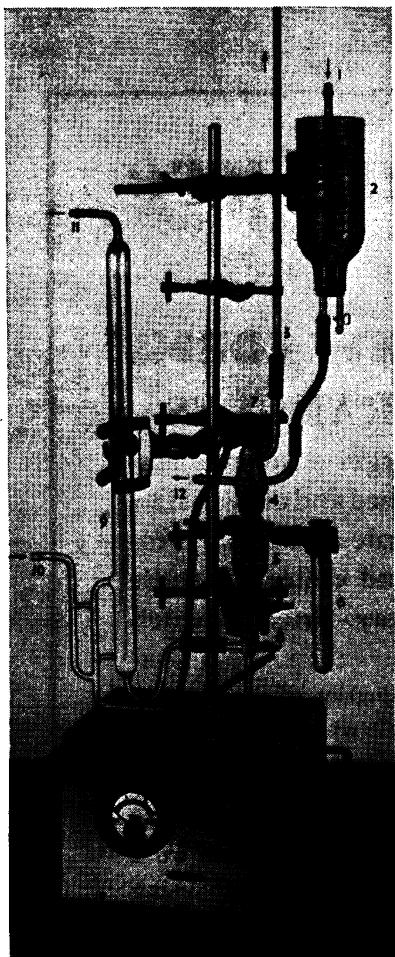

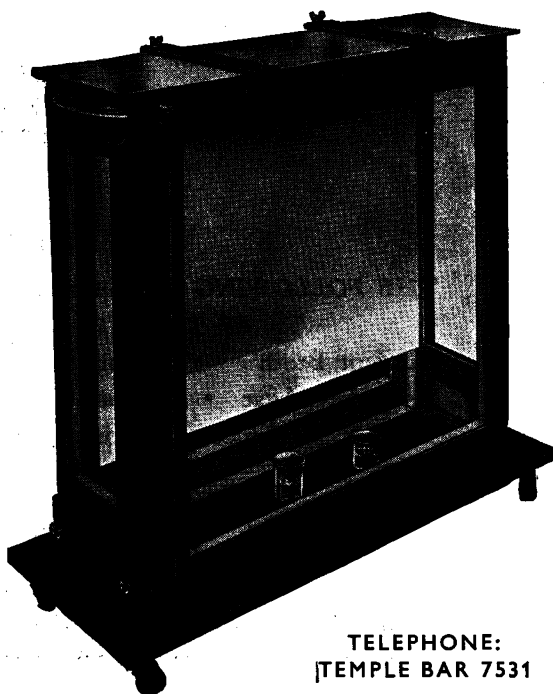

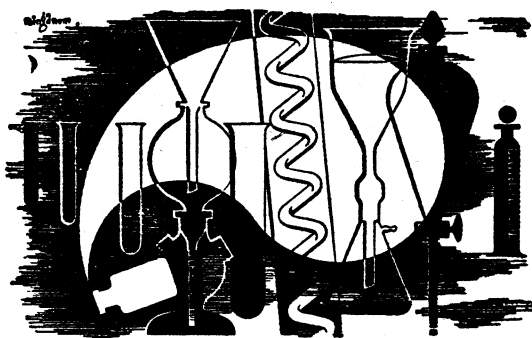
