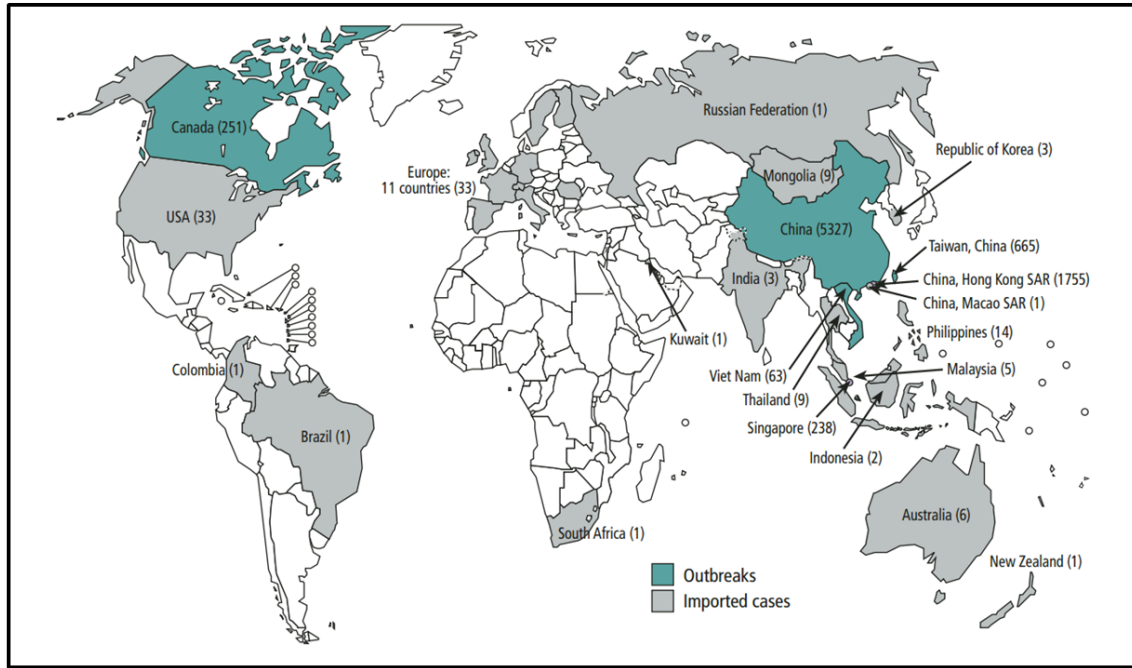
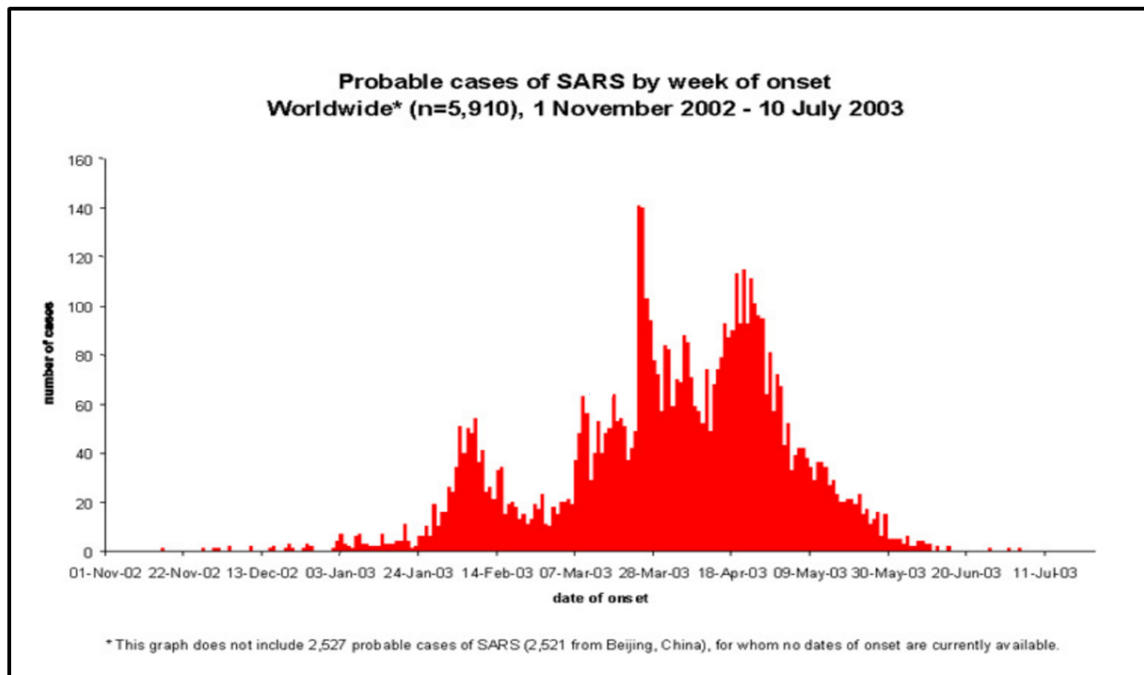


Supplementary Figure 1: Global Distribution of SARS and MERS

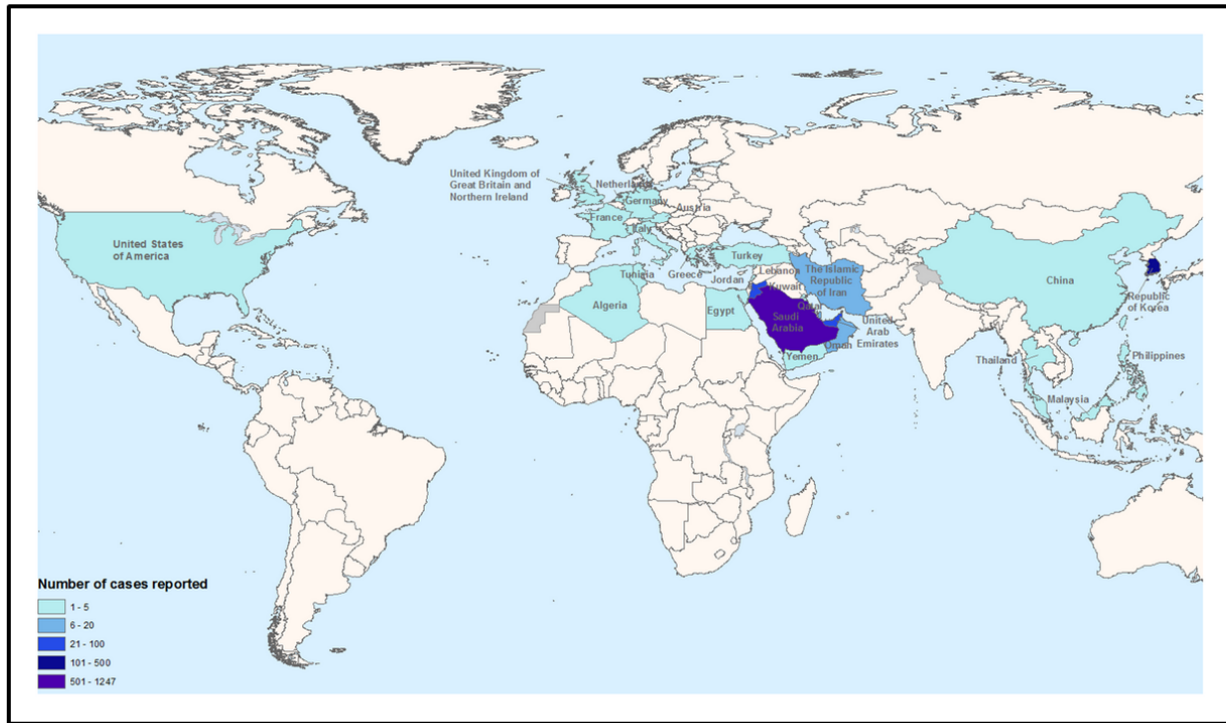
1a: Global distribution of SARS as of 7 August 2003 (Reproduced from REF. 1)



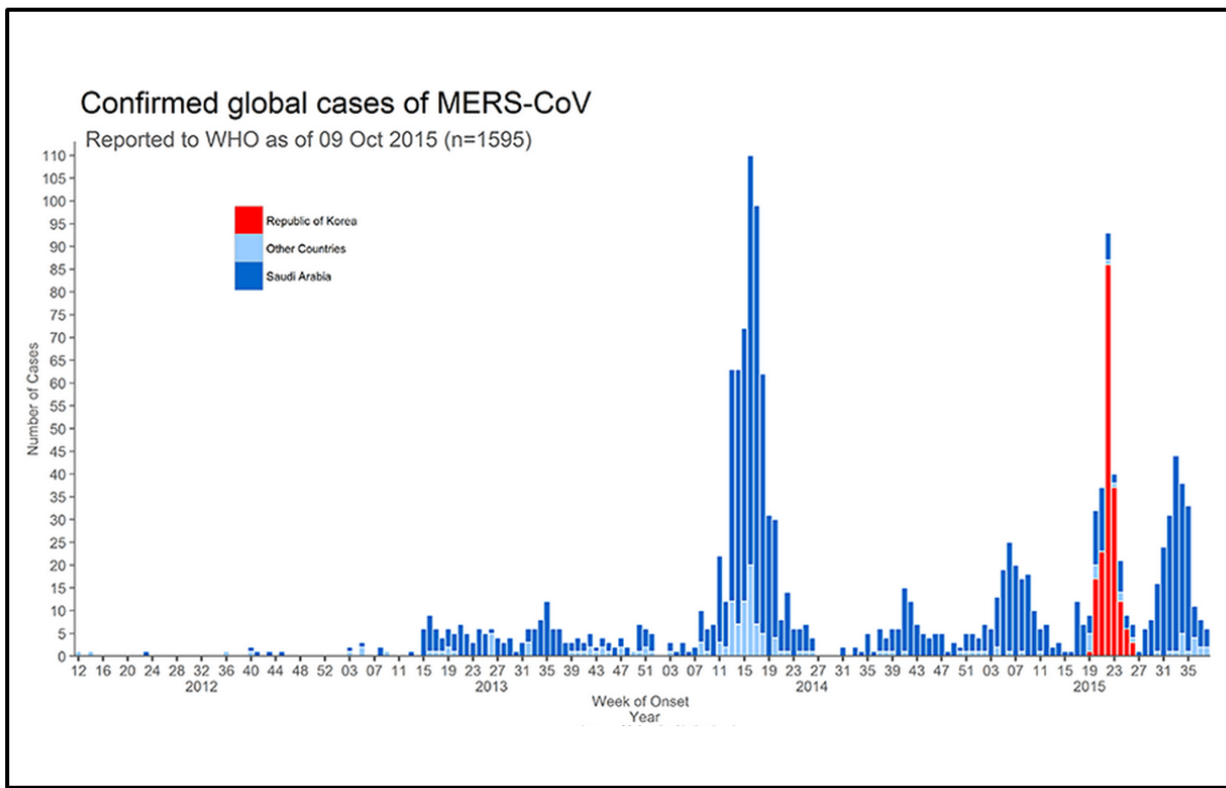
1b: Epidemic curve of probable SARS cases as of 10 July 2003 (Reproduced from REF. 2)
