MEMORANDUM FOR FILE

1. [redacted] informed [redacted] that yesterday [redacted] had been in touch with him. [redacted] had just received a telephone call from [redacted] asking if they could get together. [redacted] felt that it was probable [redacted] would like to discuss activities relating to Artichoke. Bearing in mind that he [redacted] had been instructed to confine his activities to the foreign field, he was requesting [redacted]'s permission in the absence of [redacted] to listen to a description of [redacted] relevant work.
