“The Incomplete Register” is published as a FAAn Award voters’ guide and should not be considered to be a definitive list of what you can and cannot vote for. My sources are primarily Bill Burns’ efanzines.com, Guy Lillian’s listzine ‘The Zine Dump’ and also paper zines and pdfs (or links) personally received. As I can’t possibly be aware of everything, all votes received will be counted in good faith, subject to proper categorization.

This listzine is intended to define the proper categorization of titles published in 2023, and by implication the qualifying writers, artists and loccers who have appeared therein. Please note that reprinted work from prior years is not qualifying for a 2024 individual award, even if the reprint or anthology zine in which they appear is.

The awards are sponsored by the current Corflu, which for 2024 is COR41U in Las Vegas, NV, and the results will be announced at the banquet on Sunday March 3. Current non-members wishing to view the ceremonies in real time will need a (cheap!) virtual membership. Details at corflu.org .

2024 FAAn Awards: Procedure

The sole criterion for a FAAn award vote is that work should have been published for the first time in the calendar year 2023. This includes collections of older material in a new format.

Each category invites you to vote up to five of your favorites of the year. If you wish to do so, you may check **one** selection as your “top choice”, which will then receive a bonus point toward their tally. Please be clear and obvious if you do this by designating “#1” or using an asterisk or similar.

You do NOT have to fully complete the ballot. Fill in as many (or as few) categories and slots as you are comfortable with. You do NOT have to be a member of Corflu or anything else for that matter. Voting is open to anyone with an interest in fanzines.

You do NOT have to have read or received any minimum number of fanzines to vote, although of course we encourage you to check out the contenders.

Use of the form on the following page is NOT required. Voters may alternatively send a simple list of their preferences to the award administrator by the deadline.

NOTE:

All voters are asked to clearly supply their names and contact details (physical or electronic). **Ballots lacking this information will be summarily rejected.**

VOTING DEADLINE:

Ballots should be received by midnight (PST) **Saturday February 24, 2024**

2024 FAAn Awards: Categories

FANZINE CATEGORIES

GENZINE:

A fanzine which typically has multiple contributors in addition to its editor(s).

PERZINE:

A fanzine which typically has few, if any, contributors other than its editor(s).

SPECIAL PUBLICATION:

A “one-shot” fanzine or collection or limited series (in the latter case this includes convention newsletters)

INDIVIDUAL CATEGORIES

FANWRITER:

A writer who has work first appearing in a 2023 fanzine.

FANARTIST:

An artist who has work first appearing in a 2023 fanzine.

LETTERHACK (HARRY WARNER, JR. MEMORIAL AWARD):

Loccer whose responses have appeared in a 2023 fanzine.

COVER:

Best fanzine cover (including bacovers) of 2023. Please cite title, issue # and artist.
