Signing in on PsychiatryOnline

Sign in with your American Psychiatric Association (APA) credentials on <u>https://psychiatryonline.org/</u> by clicking the Sign In area shown below:

Completed activities will have the option to View/Print Certificate of Completion, which will open your certificate via your computer file explorer, allowing you to download and save the file.

2. After selecting an activity, you will be taken to an activity overview page, which lists the target audience, education objective, details on how to earn CME credit, accreditation, estimated time to complete the activity, and activity affiliation and disclosure of program planner and author.

For earning CME credit, subscribers should read through the material presented in the article. After reading the article, complete the quiz and submit your evaluation and study hours (up to 1 AMA PRA Category 1 Credit[™]). A score of 60% or higher is required to receive credit. For the FOCUS end of year Self-Assessment, a passing score is not required but all questions must be answered and submitted. These activities do not need to be completed in a set time duration.
