Q: Why was my listing removed?

Any auctions found to have impermissibly used Solmate Socks' intellectual property will be brought to the attention of eBay for further action.

Q: Why did eBay allow me to post my auction?

A: eBay is unable to pre-screen their auctions for all unauthorized uses. Therefore, even if the auction is posted, it does not mean that sale is legal.

Q: Why wasn't I contacted directly regarding the infringement?

A: Due to the high number of auctions and eBay's VeRO program procedures, we are unable to contact each seller directly.
