¹ See the report of the second meeting of INB, contained in document A/INB/2/5, which states that “the INB agreed that the instrument should be legally binding and contain both legally binding as well as non-legally binding elements. In that regard, the INB identified that Article 19 of the WHO Constitution is the comprehensive provision under which the instrument should be adopted, without prejudice to also considering, as work progresses, the suitability of Article 21. This identification is made mindful that the decision will be made by the World Health Assembly.”
