EQUALITY AND NON-DISCRIMINATION

The parliament marked IDAHOBIT on 17 May. The Equal Opportunities Commission <u>said</u> on the occasion that important steps for LGBT equality <u>remain</u> to be taken.

FAMILY

In September, the parliament <u>voted</u> against cohabiting unmarried couples adopting children.

PARTICIPATION IN PUBLIC, CULTURAL AND POLITICAL LIFE

Long-time <u>LGBT activist</u> and openly gay politician Paolo Rondelli continued speaking up for LGBTI rights after having been one of two captains regent, San Marino's heads of state (see <u>here</u> and <u>here</u>).

The parliament $\underline{approved}$ establishing a $\underline{symbolic\ sign}$ about the rights of LGBT people in the $\underline{historic\ centre}$.

SEXUAL AND REPRODUCTIVE RIGHTS

The <u>decriminalisation</u> of abortion approved in September 2022, started to be applied from February 2023 and more than 20 women requested the assistance of public welfare.
