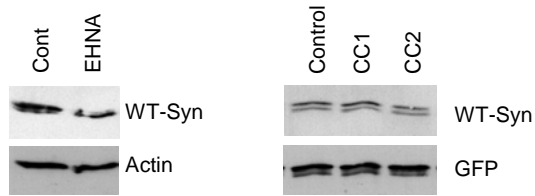

Dynein inhibition does not affect the clearance of wild-type α -synuclein.



Dynein inhibition does not affect the clearance of wild-type α -synuclein.

PC12 cells stably expressing wild-type α -synuclein (WT-syn) were induced for 24 h after which the expression was switched off by removing doxycycline from the medium for the next 24 h. Cells were treated either with or without EHNA or were co-transfected with coiled-coil domains 1 or 2 of p150^{Glued} (CC1, CC2) and pEGFP (3:1) during the switch-off period, after which they were harvested for western blot analysis. The blots were probed with anti-HA antibody to detect the transgene and anti-actin/anti-GFP as a loading control.
