CECIL ALEXANDER ROBERTS Soors States:-

I am the Assistant Commissioner of Crime stationed at Criminal Investigation Department Headquarters, Eve Loazy, Georgetown. On Saturday 18th Movember, 1978 as a result of information received I left Georgetern on Sunday 19th Movember, 1978 for Jemestern, Morth West Magisterial District. I left in company with Detective Inspector Centle; Detective Inspector London; Detective Inspector Jagnoban and other policemen. I arrived at Jenestern an Monday 20th Movember, 1978 at 10.00 a.m. in company with emm Odell Mondan; (called and identified). The reason for visiting Jonestown so late it was because of lack of transportation and in addition soldiers of the Guyana Defence Force had not reported to me what had actually occurred at Jonestown. On my arrival at Jonestown I saw a large number of dead bodies of human beings in an area close to a large text. The number of dead bodies I saw looked like between 400 to 500. The area is which bodies were; was eas; and after checking bodies individually I counted 914 bodies dead. The said Odell Rhodes an imprican citizen in company with Police party commenced the identification of the dead persons that were lying in the aforementioned area. As each body was identified a small yellow tag bearing the name of the dead person was tied onto the waist of the dead person so identified. At the said time a list was made of every person so identified. The said list was made in my presence by Inspector Centle on information given to him by the said Odell Ehodes. Later that said day in the afternoon the Government Bacteriologist Forensic Pathologist Dr. Leslie Mootoo arrived with a Medical Team at Jonestown scene. The said bodies in particular the body of James Warren Jones and Elizabeth Moore were identified by the said Odell Rhodes and shown to the said Government Pathologist. These two bodies were shown to the said Pathologist as they appeared to have gun shot wounds. Subsequently a quantity of tapes, personal letters, passports and other miscellansous documents were seized and taken away by the Police. The number of American Passports that were found totalled 803. A list of the said passports was also made by the said Inspector Centle. The said passports were subsequently handed over to a representative of the American Rabassy in Guyana-As a result of a request from the American Rabassy I gave to them 670 finger print records abstracted imagnation body cards. Subsequently I got a list of names purporting to be the names of said dead, some of the dead persons I mer

at Jonestown. This is the said list it consists of 15 pages of Telex Message purporting to come from the Dever Delaware Forensic Laboratory, Tendered, admitted and marked exhibits "Al to Aly" to which location the said dead bodies were removed by the American Government. Twenty-two other bodies were found in an area other than the area where the bulk of the bodies were found. Thirteen of the said 33 bodies were found in the house of James. Warren Jones, the said home was identified by the said Odell Mhodes. Twelve " of these bodies showed signs of consistent with poisoning and one body (i.e.) that of Ann Elizabeth Moore which appeared to have a gur shot wound on the left side of her head. On a bed in the first bedroom a Body identified as Maria Estooris was lying face downwards. She was appeared to have a frothing discharge from the mouth. Ann Elizabeth Moore body was on the floor; in the said room on another bed was the dead bodies of a young child 7 to 8 years. The child was identified as that of Timothy Jones. The child was about 7 to 8 years old. The next bediroom had some dead bodies also the masher of which I now remember to be 9. Two of those bodies were given; one, as Karren Layton age 19 and Jim McMlvain. In another building identified by the said Odell Rhodes as a hospital were four more bodies (dead) and in another hospital like building were a further five bodies very elderly women. All the bodies except ann Elizabeth Moore had no external marks of violence; appeared to be consistent with poison. There were empty vials and cups around which were seized and taker away by the police. At least about seven bottles had the label Potassium Cyanide and had a liquid in them. These said bottles were also seized and taken away by the police for analysis exemination. I number of disposable injections containing a brownish liquid were also taken away and sent for examination by Government analyst. There were also a number of Plastic drinking cups. These were all found when I saw the bulk of the dead bodies. They also bore traces of containing a brownish liquid. There was also a large steel metal drum cut in half containing brownish liquid. There were also some torn open cool aid packets in the said area where bulk of dead bodies were. The dwelling houses - 150 yards from where bulk of bodies were found. The said items which appeared to certain traces of the said brownish liquid were found under a tent or thereabout. I also say loud speaking equipment. The

CYRIL LESLIE MOOTOO Swort States:-

I am Government Semior Bacteriologist and Pathologist, my address in at the Central Medical Laboratory, Georgetown. I am also a graduate of the University of Dublin, Edinborough and I am also a Registered Medical Practitioner. On 20th Boyenter, 1978 I went to Jonestown Borth West Magisterial District and was shown several huntred of dead bodies some were identified to me by Odell Rhodes, this person (identified). I performed post mortem examination on some of the bodies. This I did in the presence of A.C.C. Roberts. I really started my exemination of the said fead bodies on the Monday might 20th November, 1978. I slept at Jonestown about 50 yards from the dead bodies. The first body I performed post mortes with dissection on after it was identified by the said Odell Rhodes was the body of James Warren Jones. On eramination I found he had a bullet wound on the right aspect of the skull just above the right ear, directly above the right ear. There was a larger wound on the left side of his head above the left ear. On closer examination I found the wound on the right side was the entrance wound and that on the left side exit wound. I sav evidence of a near discharge. From my experience I would say it was a .38 weapon. In my estimation I would say he had died 56 to 60 hours before I started to work on him. I started to work on the 21st Movember, 1978 about 9.00 a.m. The said body would have died after Saturday 18th November, 1978 midday. The cause of death Compound fracture of the skull, laceration of the brain due to gun shot injury. The area of the

entrance wound is one of the swicids area from a right handed person. Next body was found in a room identified by Odell Rhodes as that of Ana Elizabeth Moore (approximately) 26 years. On examination I found she too had a head injury the entire left aspect of the head was blown off and the brain was scattered all over the floor. There were no injury on her body. In my opinion that could not have been self inflicted she was surdered. I did a partial 🗻 dissection but found no abnormality. I examined James Warren Jones abdoman and found no abnormality also. The cause of Ann Elizabeth Hoore's death was due to a compound commuted fracture of the left side of the wault and bone of skull with laceration of the brain due to gun shot injury. A weapon of a high velocity such as a high powered rifle was used to cause her death. I then carried out post mortem toricology study for poison on several other dead bodies among these that had been identified by the said Odell Ehodes. From the rostrum the identified bodies with tags would be on your left. I then went into the other groups of dead bodies on the right and back of where I was standing I made spot checks on some of those bodies which had not been identified. I made a list of the names of the dead bodies which were identified by Odell Rhodes. This is my said list tendered, admitted and marked exhibit 'B'. I did also a toxicology study for poison on 25 unidentified dead bodies from different parts. Death was due to acute cyanide poison. In my estimation death could have supervens Saturday 18th November, 1978. A lethal dose of cyamide could kill a child in five minutes and a baby less. From what I saw most person died between twenty and thirty minutes after taking lethal dose of Cyamide poison (This is drinking). The entire presises in front of rostrum was littered with plastic cups with or without this redish brown solution. There were syringes on a deak on the rostrum unused on a wooden container, there were vials of value and ampoods of valies. This value is a tranquiliser. There was a bottle containing phenegram tablets which is another mild tranquiliser which is used in treatment of alergy. There was a large bottle (8 os.) containing chlorally late and this is used to put little children to sleep. I also as about 7 (1 litre) bottle containing Potassium cyamide with labels and two litre bottles containing potassium choloride. If injected or drunk suppress the heart best and makes death easier. Tests were carried out on the syringes and the half steel drum of cool aid and erms of the remnents in the runs and there were all moditive for notassium

cyanide. The other stuff such as the potassium bottle, values etc were given to analyst for examination. The objective was to prove what label it carried that was its contents. I got back one report from the analyst that in a bottle labelled values there was also cyanide. The action of Potassium cyanide is a respiratory supressor and gives the effect of chemical suffocation because it interferes with taking up of oxygen by the lungs. I see this exhibit "Al to Al3" and soong the names of some appears are some of the manes of the persons I carried out Post Morten examination as shown on exhibit "B".

Certain bodies were identified to me by Odell Ehodes (identified) and upon instructions I took photographs of the body identified to me as James Warren Jones and made prints from negatives, this is the photographs of James Warren Jones tendered, admitted and marked exhibit Cl and C2. I also took a photograph of Ann Elizabeth Moore, this is the said photograph of A.E. Moore tendered, admitted and marked exhibit of the various points of Jonestown, these are the said photographs "D". I also took fifteen photographs tendered, admitted and marked El to El5.
The photograph 'El' shows Jones' house 'E2' scene of poison, 'E3' shows another picture of James W. Jones. 'E4' shows Marceline Jones, wife of James Warren Jones. 'E5' shows accome af poison vials. 'E5' shows dead bodies in bulk mear pavillion. 'E7', 8, 9 and 10' show more dead bodies. 'E11, 12, and 13' shows

dead bodies inside James Warren Jones house. 'El4' shows bodies near to howe and arrow and 'El5' shows guns found.

ODELL RECORS Sworm States:-

I am an Electronic Techinolian, originally halling from Detroit, Elchigan, United States of America. I am unmarried and was 8 years in the service of the United States of America Signal Corp and Infantry battalion and was a member of the People's Temple. I joined it in California, U.S.A. It was a religious body and I joined same in October, 1976. We were shown movies in San Francisco, E.S.A. by members of the People's Temple. Those persons who showed files to us included James Warren Jones also known as and called Jim Jones called also Eswerend Jones and Cather; as a result of what I saw on those files I decided to come to Guyana. I arrived here on August 22nd, 1977. I arrived in Geogratown and came to Jonestown by boat. There was a party of twenty-mix of us from United States of America. I am not sure any of these persons are alive and I do know most of the names. When I got to the said settlement at Jonestown I

I had an American Passport. By passport was given to a member of the party I came with in U.S.A. The person I gave same to name is Somie James. I saw my passport in Jonestown when I was to get married in July, 1976. I arrived at Jonestown at 2.00 a.m. and was net by Jim Jones and a few others. The mext day the party which I came with (26) were given job assignments. I was assigned to do agricultural work, plant cassava. We were not allowed to leave settlement, it was forbidden by Jones. There was security arrangements; about one months after I arrived I notice same. There were armed guards who patrolled the settlement, they would patrol on the outer perimeter of the settlement. that
These guards carried a shot gun. These carried pelts cartridges. Later on also bows and arrows including rifles were used. We had meetings usually on Tuesdays and Saturdays between 7.30 p.m. to 8.30 p.m. lasting after 12 0'clock in the might. Jim Jones presided over the said sectings. There were agricultural meetings and Ideological meetings. There was never any discussion about religion. Mails could be sent. If one wanted to send a letter they had to write same before a Committee comprising of three persons and headed by Rita Tupper. I see this document exhibit "AJ" No. 357 on this list reflects the name of Rita Tupper. This is the said Rita Tupper who headed Committee. There were about twenty to twenty-five persons attached to the Security Staff. On mights about four or five of them were armed. At the tower a security guard would stay there and watch; mostly women were guards at the tower. I mever went up the said tower before until today and from there I could see the entire camp. I once 1 wrote a letter to Jim Jones expressing my desire to leave settlement and I also expressed my said desire in front of a public gattering at the pavillion. I was punished by being put to do longer hours because of desire to leave. There were others who wanted to leave namely: Tom Fartak, he was about thirty-five years. As a result he was given physical punishment; he was beaten by the security guards on Jim Jones instructions. He was cuffed about. There were others who wanted to leave but were prevented from so doing and each of them was punished. In September, 1978 Jim Jones told us persons from the United States of America were coming to over run settlement and as a result there was an exercise of five or six days alert. We had to are ourselves with weapons and keep duty around the settlement. The regular had fire arms; it was after this

that a regular security was formed. The main thing which prevented persons from leaving was the bush. Jim Jones gave no aid and no one on the settlement had any money. I was not paid for the services which I rendered. Instructions by Jim Jones on the visit of persons to the said settlement; any questions maked we were all told what to may. I never had any visitor but I was made to understand by my fellow settlers that we were to praise the organization and make as if life in the settlement was O.K. During the month of September, 1978 a resident in the United States of America was seeking to have the custody of her child who was a resident of the said settlement and Jim Jones was not pleased about this. The name of this child is John Victor Store called John Jones and he was about seven to eight years old. Around the 14th Movember, 1978 I was informed by Jim Jones together with other members of the settlement that Leo Ryan Congressman intended to visit the said settlement. He said he would not let that party into the said settlement. We were all made to sign a petition stating that we did not wish Lec Ryan and his party to visit the said settlement, the said petition was signed by the members of the entire settlement including sysulf. About the 16th November, 1978 Jim Jones informed members of the said settlement through the loud speaker that he would allow Lec Ryan and his party to visit the said settlement as they would be accompanied by two lawyers of the said Organization namely: Charles Geary and Mark Lans. He told them to put on a show of happy faces for Mr. Leo Ryan and his party. There is a person in Court, Charles Krause (identified) was with them. I do not know this said individual Charles Krause before. When Mr. Leo Ryan arrived he was welcomed by settlers of the settlement, a show was put on for him. The band played for him, and there was a stage show. This was on 17th Movember, 1978. After the said show some of Mr. Ryan's party Left and some remained. On 18th Ecvember, 1978 about noon I saw Mr. Eyan and some of the members of his party. When I saw Mr. Ryan he was in the pavillion speaking to some of the staff there. Some of Mr. Ryan's party were him and some were boarding a truck to leave. About fifteen settlers were leaving with Mr. Ryan-Matter adjourned to 15th December, 1978.

ODELL RHODES Sworn States:-

When I was going to my house I saw this. The names of the settlers that were leaving were: Dale Parks, Patricia Parks, Christ O'Beal, Juanita Bough, Teens Bogue, Edith Bogue, Thomas Bogue, Monica Baghy and. Pon Sly a settler attacked the Congressman Lec Ruan with a knife whilst he was on the pavillion speaking to the staff. Don Sly called Ujara came from the back threw his arms around the Congressman's mack and pulled the said Congressman backwards to him, he had a kmife in his hand; a crowd gathered and the Congressman was rescued. This was done by some of the settlers. I did not see Jim Jones around there at the time. About 1.30 to 2.00 p.m. the Congressman and his party with the settlers left. After they left Marceline Jones came unto the public address mystem and assured us everything was alright and wanted everyone to go to their homes. About half hour after Marceline Jones had spoken Jim Jones came on the loud speaker and requested everyone to assemble in the pavillion. This pavillion I pointed out to Coroner and Jury yesterday 14th December, 1978. I went. Maying assembled there we sat for about ten to fifteen minutes. When I got there I did not see Jim Jones. Shortly before the meeting was called I saw the said two lawyers namely Charles Teary and Mark Lans welking away from the pavillion talking. If a person did not attend a meeting when same was called by Jim Jones he would be punished. On this accasion he requested the security men to check on all the houses to make sure all the settlers were at the meeting. He did so over the public address system. Those settlers who were aged or in the hospital were not required to attend. The Rouse which I hid under and pointed out to the Coroner and Jury housed the Senior Citizens; who were in meed of hospital care were not required to attend. After waiting ten to fifteen minutes at the Pavillion Jim Jones came and said "everyons must commit suicide"; as there was a man who planned to shoot the pilot of the plane taking Congressman Lee Ryan and his party down as the plane was in the air; he went on to say this said man who going to shoot the said plane had blased his sister for his sother's death (i.e.) the man sister and the man's mother. He further added that suicide was the only way out as the Guyana Defence Force would come in and torture babies, children and Semior citisen. He had also said that the said plane would creak in the jungle and all

on board would die. A few mouths before Mr. Leo Ryan came Deborah alias Debi Blakly left the said Organisation People's Temple in Guyana and had returned to the United States of America and went before a grand jury and gave testimony that things were not right at the settlement in Jonestown. This was told to us by Jim Jones himself about three months before 18th December, 1978. After Blakey defected; her mother Leiss Layton got sick and got worse and died-Christine Hiller objected to suicide proposal and said that swicide was not the only way out as the man might not shoot the pilot. Jim Jones in reply said the man would shoot the pilot if the plane ever left the ground. One Lew Ester Lewis a settler told Miller she had no right, objecting. Several persons join with Lewis shouting down Miller. Jim Mac Klwain took the mike and told Miller ahe oved her life to Jim Jones and she had no reason to complain. All this took place in about two to three minutes. Over the public address system Jim Jones gave orders that the poison be brought out. Just before this request a vehicle drove into the compound. The said vehicle came in with speed. Johnny Jones age about thirty years went and spoke to Jim Jones, Jim Jones then said it is too late everybody is dead and then said bring the poison. There were many persons number about ten to fifteen persons, men and somer went and brought the poison; they went to the Medical area. They kept going and coming. I saw a large drum steel with liquid. I also saw Burses carrying handful of syringse; cups (disposable) were also brought. The Doctor Larry Shack went into the green tent which I also pointed out to the Coroner and members of the Jury, this tent is next to the said pavillion where we had all been sitting. A table was then brought to the pavillion and syringes were opened on the table by ten to fifteen persons; the container of the large drum was brought over small plastic container with brownish liquid were also brought over from the tent where Shack had been. I saw the label "Potassium Cyanide" on those bottles which I had aforementioned as gallon bottles. I also saw some bottles with labels marked Potassium Chloride. I see eghibit "B2", this picture shows the drum, this was placed next to the table. The table is also shown an exhibit "R2". Somes kept saying hurry, hurry take the babies first. A woman name Roulseta Paul took her small child Robert Junior (name of child) 11 year eld. She took a syringe filled with brownish liquid and squanted it into the

child's mouth; this said syringe had no needle. She also took another syringe which also filled with this brownish liquid and squinted it in her own mouth. There were several of these syringes filled with brownish liquid lying on the said table which the said drum was next to. She walked away along this wooden pathway and want into a position not shown in exhibit "R2" and sat down. Hostly females lined up with babies to get this syringe. Some one had banded to me a small child named Deryck Johnson about ten to elever years of age and asked ge to help him he had collapsed and I noticed him eyes were rolling and he went into convulsion and I put him to lie down outside in the fields. There was an alert call man, months before this and people were asked to drink cool aid drinks and were told by Jim Jones it was poison and they drank same at the maid pavillion, nothing happened, they just went into the pavillion and sat down. On this occasion having seen this child dying I realised it was in fact poison which was in the drum. I started picking children up off the ground and putting them down. I was a teacher and I was just trying to comfort them. I spent about fifteen minutes there and then welked about four or five yards away and began contemplating what I should do. There were armed guards about fifty. Some were armed with fireerss and bows and arrows. They were there preventing settlers from leaving. Doctor Shack said he needed a stathscope and I relayed this message to a nurse name Phyllis Chaiken and she started walking towards the Furses Office and I walked with her. The murses office is about one hundred and twenty-five yards from the pavillion. This said Nurses Office I also pointed out to the Coroner and Jury on 14th December, 1978 during visit to Jonestown. I want to the Burses Office for stethescape and she want to the Doctor's Office for stethecope. I went through the back door of the Murses Office and unto the dwelling quarters of the Semior Citizens. There were about ten semior citizens and a lady nurse also took care of them. This said lady nurse surname is Smith. I then went/of the back door of the senior citizen quarters and went and hid under the building. I went in hiding for about thirty minutes, it was just about getting dark. While under the said senior citizen building I heard over the loud speaker a request that all persons with arms were to go to the radio room. When I heard this call I left my hiding place and went to the bakery. I saw no one there. From the bakery I went to Phisiotherapy building. From

there I went through the Cooking area. I was no one here also. I was not walking I was running because I was afraid. I went into the bushes and I had to cross an open field. I ran about five yards into the bushes and followed the tree line and came out by the front gate. I eventually came out on the road and went to Port Kaituma and went to the People's Mational Congress Office. I saw some one there and reported what happened. This was about 11.30 to 12.30 that said might. On 14th December, 1978 I pointed out to the Coroner and memburs of the Jury the loud speakers on the Poles and cottages 31 and 53 which housed small boys. On said visit 14th December, 1978 I went into the guard tower and saw the front section of a small transmitter. I also pointed out to the said mambers of the Jury and Coroner cottage where I lived and also cottage 45 where Stanley Clayton lived. I also pointed out cottage No. 8 where Mary ige Bouge and about severteer other persons lived. At the said settlement husband and wives would live together but children were put to live with children of their own age. A house parent was put in charge of them. There was one house in which twenty-three girls lived; they were between ten to thirteen years old. There was another house where there were nine boys about twelve to fourteen years old lived. The names of some of the Security guards are: Bruce Oliver, Billy Oliver, Charles Marshall, by there Tow and Bob, Romie James, Joe Wilson and others. Right of the 18th Edvember, 1978 I reported matter to Police, then in company with the Police I went tack to Jonestown on Monday 20th Mursaber, 1978 and I identified some dead bodies numbering 174. As I identified the bodies Inspector Sertle was making a list of the names of the persons I identified, their sex and apparent age. This is the list tendered, admitted and marked exhibit 'A to F6'. I also identified bodies to Doctor Leslie Mootoc who inspected the bodies. I see exhibit 'B' No. 35 on this list should read "Grime" instead of "Grime." and No. 39 should Brewster instead of Brusta. I went to the Senior Citizens quarters in company with the Police and saw four dead bodies. I could only identify one body he was the only male; he was about eighty years old. There was a dead body of woman sitting in a chair. She was about sixty years old. Toza. Cross-examined:-

q. by members of the Jury:- I was travelling all the time from Georgetown to Jonestown when I arrived there at 2.00 a.m. as we had lost our way.

Question: We all signed the petition under durees.

Question: I did not see any adult settler refusing to drink poison. When I left there were only a few adult who had taken poison.

by Coroner: Richael Carter a mettler from the said Jonestown was one of the radio operators.

I was also a teacher at Jonestown and taught children eight to fourteen years old.

VRRNOB GENTLE Sworn States:-

I am Detective Inspector of Police stationed at Criminal Investigation Department Readquarters, Eve Leary, Georgetown. I went to Jonestown in com-Pany with A.C.P. Roberts on 20th November, 1978 about 10.00 a.m. This witness Odell Shodes was also in our company. I saw a large number of dead bodies at Jonestown lying under a large tent and around it. I also saw in Jim Jones' house thirteen dead bodies and I also visited the Eosyital where I found other dead Modies about mine. On instructions from the A.C.C. Cdell Mhodes accompanied me in order I make a list of the bodies he identified and I made a list of the bodies he identified. I see this list exhibit P1 to F6, this is the said list I made (identified). The said dead bodies were smaller and in a state of advance decomposition. I also noticed needle marks on the arms of some of the dead bodies. I found a number of imerican Passports in a building marked office. A · List was made of these passports. I seized the said passports and later handed them over to the respresentative of the American Babasay. This is the said list I made of passports tendered, admitted and marked exhibits Cl. te Cll. I also collected a set of arms and teld something about them by the Guyana Defence Force. On Zist Royanber, 1978 I was also present at Jonestown when Doctor

Mootoo a registered Medical Practitioner visited Jonestown and in my presence he performed a Post Morten examination on James Varren Jones, and Ann Elizabeth Moore; the said bodies were identified by the said Odell Ehodes. He also examined the body of Christine Miller and a number of other persons. Whilst Odell Ehodes was identifying the said dead bodies and tagged them. The dead body of the said James Varren Jones was lying on a platform. Around 23rd Movember, 1978 Personnels from the United States Army came into Jonestown and conveyed remaining dead bodies from the said Jonestown. They had Police permission, they removed nine hundred and thirteen dead bodies, one dead body was left his name was Gill he was a Guyanese.

STANLE CLATTCH Sworn States:-

I am twenty-five years old and lived at 920-39 Str., Cakland, California. About 1971 I joined the People's Temple in America and then I decided to come over to Guyana in 1977. I was given \$30.00 (4.) to prepare myself. The money was given to me by one Francine Cruishan, she was one of the persons that was responsible for the distribution of money in the Organization. I was told to take money and buy some clothes but I went and got drunk instead. I was supposed to leave at 9.00 p.m. that day I got the \$30.00 (4.). Michael Carter came to me that might about 9.30 p.m. and told me I was thirty minutes. Late. Michael Carter was the radio operator for the church. Michael Carter took me to San Francisco Airport with my consent. Mean I got to the Airport he gave me a ticket and my passport. I boarded a plane and came to Guyana

with three other persons Jamice Johnson, Joyce Johnson and Jame Johnson. They were sisters, this was in August, 1977. When I came to Guyana I stayed a few weeks in Georgetown and then went to Jonestown. I reached Jonestown in August, 1977 in the night. The next day they gave us a briefing. I was disappointed with Jonestown. Some time later I told one of the Griffiths I wanted to leave as I falt he could have helped. Griffith told Jim Jones, Charlie Touchette, Johnny Jones together with others took me to the bushes to Jim Jones. I was ... stopped threatened by Charlie Touchette and Jim Jones asked whg I wanted to leave and when I explained because of the treatment I was receiving he told me things would be better. When I first arrived in Jonestown I did agricultural work, then clearing bushes and at one time I did security work at the gate, the main entrance at one time with Odell Mhodes, Jeff Carrie, and Chick Kenfendoff. From Security I went to the kitchen as a cook. I was caught drinking and smoking whilst doing Security work and as a result I was removed from doing security work. I was purished by being made to do hard work in taking earth from the foot of a hill up to a box on top of the hill running and was being supervised by Romie James who was armed with a rifle. In Movember, 1928 I was working in the kitchen. A few days before the gisit I heard over the public address system that a United States Congressman was coming to visit the settlement. Jim Jones was opposed to the visit but never the less told the people to clean the place. The Congressman and his party arrived at Jonestown on Bovember 17th, 1978. He was welcomed by the settlers. On the 18th Movember, 1978 I saw some of the visitors that were members of the Congressman's Party; about 2 O'clock in the afternoon of 18th Movember, 1978 I saw the Congressman Ryan and his party with settlers leaving. Marceline Jones said over the loud speaker after Congressman left that everything was alright and they should return to their quarters and freshen up and meet again for that evening and discuss the events that occurred that day. About half hour after this the settlers were summoned to pavillion over the public address system. The kitchez crew does not have to attend meetings. Doctor Shacks and Joyce Touchette came into the kitchen and collected a half steel drum and had with them boxes of cool aid and two containers containing brown liquid. I know from this something was going on. There had been a previous occasion when there was a suicide drill in which Cool Aid was placed in container

and settlers were required to drink it having been told it contain portion which I understook to be poison which was fake as no one died. So when I saw them leaving with Cool aid that day I felt it was a similar drill. One of the Security guards came and ordered the kitchen staff which included me to go to the pavillion; this security guard was lew Jones, he was carrying a pistol in his pocket. This was around five to 5.30 in the afternoon. I want over to the pavillion, when I reached the pavillion I saw Christine Riller a settler telling Jim Jones that she had a right to decide what she would do with her life or mot and she must make the decision. One of the women Lew Ester Lewis got up and told Christine Miller she had no right to decide what she will do with her life and then Jim McKivair got up and said to Christins Miller if it was not for Jim Jones she would not be alive. The crowd was agreeing with Jim Mc Myair and Lew Ester Levis. Jim Jones was saying all of us got to die and Christime Miller could not make a decision for her life, it had to be made by the group. About that time the truck that carried the Congressman Party came into the compound. fast and I then say Bob Kide and Johnny Jones came off truck and Johnny Jones go to Jim Jones and said something to him. After this Jim Jones said it is too later we all must die, we got him the Congression is dead; Hews Media are also dead on the Air Strip. We must die hurry with portion; he does not want the Guyana Defence Force coming in and castrate and shooting the settlers and he did not want any of the settlers to be left alive. Fe was speaking over the Public Address system. He said words to the effect he would see everyone dead and then he would take hie life. I saw persons moving to the tack where Jim Jones was. I saw mothers taking their babies up. I saw a Burse gave a baby a sip from a cup and then saw a Burse injected a baby. After the acthers took their babies and they were injected persons would take the babies out in the fields. I saw every young babies in arms being treated in this way. I saw Joyce Touchette then hold Weil a Ruyanese adopted by her four years old and permitted a nurse to give him a mip from a cup after which she fondled him and walked out of pavillion and put the child down where other babies were and want and stood at the back of Jis Jones. Some of the settlers were crying and Jis Jones were asking them not to scare babies like that let them feel happy, let than be proud to die with dignity. Mothers were crying and persons looking

after babies. Marceline Jones went around embracing people. I heard her saying to one of the persons she would see them in the next life. All the time Jim Jones was saying over the loud speaker hurry, hurry the Guyana Defence Force were coming, some settlers were relectant to go and the members of the security were assisting the reluctant ones to go up to the table. Jim Jones came off the table and were also assisting them to go to the table telling them he love them. Jim Jones said he was finally going to rest. He was saying to the settlers over the loud speaker that it would not hurt you, you just close your eyes and go into a deep sleep. It was after the adults realised that persons were dying; they showed signs of rejuctance to die. When I realised it was the real thing, I began to move backvards from side to side looking for a way to escape. The crowd was getting less and less as persons were dying. It was not about 7 to 7.30 in the might. Between 100 to 200 persons were still alive. I heard over the public address system that persons with weapons were to report to the radio room. I saw persons with weapons going to the said radio room. There were twenty to twenty-five such persons. I started walking away from the pavillion and one of the security guard amanda Griffith asked me where I was going and I told him I was going over to ed Granishan to tell him I was going - I was going to take the portion. The guard replied ed was not over there. I told him I just saw him over there. I continued walking and he was following me. I turned back as if I was going back to pavillion. There were members of the security around the pavillion armed with bows and arrows, men and women. I went up to Karia Lance hoping she would allow me to pass and she stepped tack and pulled bow and arrow and threatened to shoot. I told her I was sent out to count the number of security persons left. I then went around to all the security men saying that I was getting ready to go. I reached Ray Jones and told him I was ready to go and he embraced as and said he would see me in the next life. I ther noticed some people in the school tent and I told Ray Jones I was going over there to tell them goodbys. On my way over I looked back and may Jones was not looking at me. I just ran towards the bushes the distance from that to bushes, I cannot estimate it. After being in the bushes for about half hour to forty-five simutes I heard cheers coming from the settlement. I remain in the bushes for another hour; then came out and when I reached about twenty-

five yards out of the bushes I heard five shots in this sequence; one shot, then another shot then a double shot and them a final shot; I immediately ran back into the bushes. I spent another hour or two is the bushes. I then came out of the bushes and made my way back to the settlement. When I reached it, it was quiet. I saw lights on in the pavillion, Doctor Office, Burses Office, one part of the kitchen and in one or two houses. I saw a light in the vicinity of the Jones house but I am not sure whether it was inside or outside. I went into the office, I saw no person dead or alive in there, there was no light. I went there to collect my passport. I got it; Pasaports were kept in a wooder box in that office. There were 40 to 50 passports in that box. It took me less than twenty seconds to find my passports. I went and look for my name. I turned on light. Passport office was about 50 yards from Pavillion. It was right in front of the cage where an ape was kept. When I reached the office I remained about five minutes in the darkness then turned on light and find my passport and then heard a shot appearing to come from somewhere in the settlement. I immediately out off light and remained there for about three to four minutes; after making sure that no one was around I went into direction of the road and took the main road leading to Port Kaitums and remained at the house of a friend near Jonestown and remained until 10.00 a.m. the next day. I then walked to Port Kaituma and went to Port Kaitima Police where I made a statement. I am not prepared to dispute, it was around 4.00 p.a. on 19th November, 1978 I concluded my statement to the Police. At Jonestown no one was allowed to amoke or drink alcohol. Police has my passport.

Cross-examined:- None.

Q. by members of the Jury. I would not be able to say whether any of Jim Jones aids were permitted to smoke or drink. I know alcohol was there but I do not know for what purpose. I do know of one instance when Jim Jones alipped up and called for branky but passed it off by saying he was using it for Hedical Ressons.

By Coroner: Jim Jones was the big boss of the settlement, he ran everything. He had power of life and death over all inmates of Jonestown.

PAUL ADAMS SHOTE States:-

I am a Security Guard Living at Port Ealtima working with Matarakai Development Authority. On Seturday 18th Movember, 1978 I was due to work from the 11 p.m. to 7 a.m. chift. As a result of something I heard I reported for duty at 9.00 p.m. (early) In order to get to my post I had to walk along the train line and I heard woices. From their accent I decided they were settlers from Jonestown. I estimated they were about five persons speaking to one another. I was not able to make out what they were saying. At my work place I told the Security guards Sealey and Kansanalli what I heard. I remained on duty at my post and about 11.55 p.m. Security Guard Gilbert Gomes told me something; as a result of what he told me I want to Port Kaituma Waterfront and hid after seeing three Americans; as soon as they were about to pass me I halted them with my gun and ordered them to go to the Out Post at Fort Kaituma. At the Out Post they were searched and some Emerican currency and Guyana currency; about five passports and two revolvers (Smith and Webson makes. 38) were found on them. These things were taken possession of by the Police. An entry was made in the diary of everything that was found on them. The diary was a Police Diary. Durga Persand made the entry in the said diary. I subsequently learnt that the three persons I arrested manes were Timothy Carter, Mike Carter, Michael Prokes. I asked them where they were going and they replied they were seeking rescus. They were taken to the Cassava Mill and later the Police took charge of then.

MICHAEL JULIAN CARTER Sworm States:-

I am an imerican Citisem. I used to live at 1810 Riviscadero St. San Francisco, U.S.A. I joined an Organization known of the People's Temple in July or August, 1973. At that time the said Organization had its Headquarters at River Valley, California. I came to Suyana in 1977 when I was in Georgetown I stopped at Lot 41 Lemaha Gardens, the Readquarters of the People's Temple. I spent six days in Georgetown when I ferst arrived in Guyana. I took the boat "Cudjoe" and came to Jonestown. My first assignment at Jonestown was working in the fields. In October, Ecvember, 1978 my main job was working as a radio operator at Jonestown; When I first arrived at Jonestown I found the opinion that Jim Jones was working very hard for the benefit of the settlers, as time went on it seemed to me his condition deterioristed. Others started to assume responsibilities. The greatest inflow of population growth of People came between July and December, 1977. Out of the 14 months I spent in Guyana before this incident mine months were spent at Jonestown and five months at Lemaha Gardens, Georgetown. When I first arrived in Jonestown I spent three months there, then three months in Lamana Gardens. The two months in Jonestown after that them two more months in Lemaha Gardens, Seorgetown and the remaining term I spent at Jonestown. When I came to Georgetown from Jonestown it was basically to purchase provisions and equipment for the radio and other electronic devices at Jonestown. At Jonestown during the month of Movember, 1978 there were three Hi frequency radio transmitter set that were operational. There were 4 or 5 other such set that were not operational and I called all that set TARSU. The sets were capable of contracting anywhere in the world at certain times of the day and night depending on the atmospheric condition. There were also three similar sets that were operational at Lamaha Gardens. The organization had a travler maked the Sudjoe and a boat named Albatross. The boats were not equiped with high frequency set. The organisation in San Francisco had high frequency set. While I was in San Francisco I would normally have four to six hours radio contact with Jonestown everyday. In San Francisco I picked up Stanley Clayton and took him to the San Francisco Airport, U.S.A. When I reached the home of Stanley Clayton I told him he was half hour late. Numbers of the People's Temple in San Francisco had to surrender their passport

to the Organization and the same applied to Jonestown in Guyana. Jim Jones said he was Rod and represented himself as having Supernatural power. At Jonestown there would be regular meeting on Tuesdays and Saturdays. At the meetings there would be testimonies by Jim Jones and those settlers who had to be disciplined would be disciplined and then plans would be discussed gensrelly. On May 19th, 1978 there was a talk about suicide when a certain settler left; then Jim Jones said she would go and spread a lot of information about the settlement at Jonestown and then they would all have to commit suicide. I was married to Joycelyn Carter. I was married in October, 1976. Her name prior to marriage was Joycelyn Brown. There was one offsyring born of this union in Georgetown on 10th May, 1977 name of child "Kajwana". On 1st Movember, 1978 I received radio message from San Francisco, U.S.A Headquarters of the People's Temple that Congressman Ryan and a Party would be arriving in Guyana on 15th November, 1978. The information conveyed to me was that the Congressman Ryan would be coming with another Congressman; members of the News Media and some relatives of the settlers at Jonestown. I handed messages to person who was required to receive same. I got the impression that Jim Jones was willing to let in Congressman Ryan and his aidebut no one else. On Friday afternoon 17th Movember, 1978 Jim Jones from his house called a meeting over the loud speaker; this was called an "alert". Marceline Jones spoke to her husband Jim Jones over the telephone telling him that there was no sense in calling the "alert". What Jim Jones did say over the loud speaker is "alert" "alert" we are being invaded.* It was then that Marceline Jones argued with Jim Jones to call "alert" off and after helf hour of arguing Jim Jones finally called it off. At that time I was in the radio roos trying to contact San Francisco, U.S.A. since it was the regular time. The Congressman Ryan, his side, a Guyana official, and two of the Templefs Lawyers Charles Gairy and Mark Lane arrived is Jonestown about 4.30 to 5.00 0'clock that afternoon. After Mark Lane and Charles Gairy spoks to Jim Jones the members of the News Media and relatives of the settlers at Jonestown came in. Congressmen Ryan started talking to settlers of Jonestown. There was a show at about 7.30 p.m. and then members of the News Redia and other persons making up Ryan's party arrived. The Congressman Ryan with his side, Mark Lane and Charles Gairy overnighted at Jonestown, the other members of the

party left Jonestown. Bout 9.00 a.m. on the Saturday morning 18th Movember, 1978 I may Congressman Ryan in the pavillion speaking to settlers one at a time. The night before he spoke to Bouquett and other persons. I do not know the names of the persons he spoke to on the morning of the 18th Movember, 1978. I may the Hows Media and other members of the party arrived this man about 11.30 a.m. and they sere speaking to settlers in the vicinity of the pavillion. I was then in the radio room. I sent a message to the Headquarters at Lamaha Gardens, Georgetown that everything was going well; the message was sent to Sharon Amos. About 1.30 p.m. Hr. Dick Dryer from the United States Embassy in Guyana came to the radio room and sent a message saking for another plane to carry out settlers. The Bahasay promised to send one. Hr. Dryer returned about twenty to thirty mimites later and sent a message to Sharon amos saying that a family of seven persons and two other individuals wanted to leave Jonestown and she should relay this message to the United States Embassy in Georgetown. The first message was also relayed through Sharon Amos. A message came back through Sharon imos that United States Embass; was sending a plane capable of carrying five persons. About one hour after Mr. Dryer returned again and asked me to send another message that another twelve persons wanted to leave. I passed this message to Sharoz Amos. About one hour after this arrangements were made for the visitors to leave together with those settlers who desired to leave. Congressman Ryan had decided to remain to settle a dispute involving Al Simon, his wife and children. Al Simon wanted to leave, the wife wanted to remain and insisted that children remained with her. After ab incident in which Congression Ryan was involved be decided to leave. One truck left with Ryan and his party. I was back in the radio room. Marceline Jones then came on the Public address system and told everyone "everything will be alright they must go home and relax". Maria Katsareis, the financial secretary of the said Organization came into the radio room and told me to tell Georgetown we were having power problems and we would have to shut off the radio. I shut off radio and took out a part of the radio and gave It to her. This was around 3.45 P.B. to 4.00 p.m. I think it was Paula Adams whom I gave message to in Georgetown. I remained in Radio room and about forty-five minutes later Reverend Jones semounced over the loud speaker system that every one was to attend a meeting

at the pavillion. People started going in the pavillion and taking up seats and at the same time Maria Katsarsis came and spoke to me. I was at that time outside the radio room, I saw my brother Timothy Carter following Maria Katsarsis and she called both of us into the room next to the redioroom. She them told us Rike Prokes was going to be carrying a heavy suit case and sasked us if we would be willing to help him. I then went to my home and changed my clothes and Timothy Carter went to his home. After changing I went to the west house where Jim Jones lived. This house has three rooms. The first room had a refrigerator, the second from an iron safe and the third room beds and desks. I did not go into the house. I saw Mike Prokes sitting on the steps of the third room with a suit case. I spoke Mike. Maria Katsaris then handed to me a pistol and also handed Mike Frokes one and told us if we were caught we were to bill ourselves. I subsequently learnt that suit case had money. At the same time she handed was our Passport and also handed to Mike Prokes Timothy Carter's passport. Passports were kept in a building which Joyce Touchette and husband lived. This was near the cage of the ape. I asked Frokes where we were to go and he said we were to go to the Embassy in Town. Raria Katsarsis had bid us farewell, we were awaiting Timethy Carter and he arrived about this time. I thought there was going to be some trouble and one of the things was suicids. We went to a postion outside the settlement. This was around 5.30 p.m. I could not hear the Public address system. On my leaving I saw no dead bodies. The first place we stopped was in a tanana field in the settlement. This banana field is about 1500 yards over a bill and out of might of the pavillion it was also out of hearing of the Public address system. We sat in the field and had a discussion, Mike Prokes had said that he learnt from Maria Katsarsis that things were out of hand and they were going after Congressman Ryan. Prokes unain the case and then I saw the contents which consisted of foreign currency, Guyans currency to smaller extent, I saw three boxes of jevellery, rings and necklaces and then I saw an envelope it was addressed to the Soviet Rabssey in Georgetown. I opened the envelope and found at last two typewritten absets of paper, it was too dark to read. It was signed. We took out six packs of foreign currency; each packet measured about four to five inches high and the length of an ordinary United States currency note. We dug mix holes and buried the money in the same location; money was in plastic

I could estimate that were living at the said settlement. I never went back to Jonestown. During the time I was at Jonestown; I went with A.C.C.

Hoberts to the chicken farm and there I pointed out the chicken feed bag in which I had left soney. I also pointed out the suit case. I also took A.C.C.

Hoberts to the bahana fields where money was buried. I could not at that time find where money was buried but later with the assistance of Mike Prokes and my brother Timothy Carter money was recovered. Police took possession of all these things. The guns that were given to us by Maria Estearsis had assumition mine had five rounds and I later removed those and put them in my pocket. I saw Security Guards at Jonestown. Persons were not permitted to leave Jonestown if they wanted.

PROPERT JAMES CANTER C/d EDICTRY CARTER also called TDE CARTERSworm States:-

I am a citizen of the United States of America. I lived at 1859 Geary
Boulevard, San Francisco, California, United States of America. I am a Typewritten and word Processing Specialist, I used to work on the I.B.H. Typewriter.
In January, 1973 I joined the People's Temple and Jim Jones was in charge of

the said Organisation. I did Secretarial work for the said Organisation at . . the premises of the People's Temple Organisation where I lived. In 1974 I understood that the People's Temple wanted to set up an Agricultural project in Guyana. Sometime in 1974 I believed that the said Agricultural Project was set up. Jim Jones had made two or three trips from the Headquarters in the States to Guyana over a period of time. May or June, 1977 % came to Guyana. He called the project the "Promise Land." August, 24th 1977 I came to Guyana. I came with Eve and Jim Pugh. Eve Pugh was the treasurer. Jim Pugh was a long standing member. When I came to Guyana I spent about one week at Lot 41 Lamaha Gardens, Georgetown then I went to Jonestown. I came to Matthews Ridge by plane and ther went over land to Jonestown. At that time there were aix hundred to seven bundfed persons at the settlement at Jonestown. Agricultural work was done at the time; it appeared to me that the people were quite happy. In December, 1977 I moved to Lamaka Gardens to live. In September, 1977 he . Jim Jones asked the assembly at Jonestown how many people wanted to commit suicide and about 12 of them raised their hands in approval. At Jim Jones request in 1976 I signed a letter that I no longer desire to live, this was a test of loyalty. I was married in the States. My wife came to Suyana before I did in late June, 1977. In 1974 I was legally married in the States to Barbara Hoyer. I was separated from her then had a relationship with Gloria Rodrigues over a period of time and this is the person whom I referred to as my wife. She came in June, 1977. She was programt at that time. She gave birth to a child in August, 1977 in Georgetown, name of child is Malcolm James Carter. In September, 1977 over a period of several days six rounds were fired at Jonestown. I did not see who fired those rounds no one was injured. I was at different places at the time of this incident in September, 1977. In Movember there was an instance of a discharge of one round. I did not see person who discharge round. In December, 1977 also one round discharged again I did not see the persons who discharged round. To one was injured on any of these occasions. I know there were shot guns at Jonestown. Six people who comprised guard of Jim Jones used those shot guns to protect his house and it was said it was because of the incidence I referred to above in September; November and December, 1977. There was no guard from the settlement. I never moticed bows

and arrows. If a settler wanted to leave Jonestown they would have been prevented. I cleared the bushes and was an administration for the Medical Department. I was assigned to prepare the Organizational Chart for the Medical Team. At that time in December, 1977 there were only twenty members of the Medical Team. As a result of any assignment I spoke to Phillis Chaikin who was the Burse in charge of the Hedical Team. I set up a system for the ordering of Medical supplied, the visiting hours of the Doctors, Burses and Pharmacist. I did this job for about four weeks; December, 1977 I went to Georgetown to do customs work. I prepared papers for doing custom work. I remained in Georgetown doing customs work and Community relation work until October, 1978. During that time I made brief visits to Jonestown; in October, 1978 I went to the States and returned to Guyana about a week before 18th of Rovember, 1978. I got information that Congressman Ryan and a Party were going to visit Jonestown, this was when I was in the States in October; Movember, 1978. Whilst in the States I had discussions with relatives in the States of settlers in Jonestown and on my return to Guyana I told Jim Jones about this proposed visit of Gongressman Ryan and the relatives of the settlers. Jim Jones was wormed about the intention of Congressman Ryan and his party on this visit. When I told Jim Jones about this I was in Jonestown; the Tuesday of the week of the visit. The Friday of the week 17th November, 1978 Congressman Ryan, his mide, Charles Gairy, Mark Lane and a man from the Ministry of Information arrived at Jonestown. I was there when they arrived about forty-five minutes after their arrival Jim Jones came up and spoke to Congressman Ryan. After the conversation which Jim Jones had with the Congressman Jim Jones agreed to allow all the other members of the Party to come into Jonestown except one; the person who was prevented was Gordon Mindsay of the Mational Enquior Hevs Paper. Congressman Ryan and his party spoke to settlers after which there was a show. The next day I heard Edith Parks expressed desire to leave, this was done to one of the Newsmen; after that more and more people expressed desire to leave. There were about twenty settlers who expressed desire to leave all left except Al Simon. All this time I was in the pavillion. I was is discussion with Congressman Ryan, Charles Gairy, Mark Lane when Donald Sly called Don Sly called Sjara, Don Sly came up and saked me whom I was speaking to and when I told him that it

was Congressman Ryan he went behind him and put his hands around him and said all right nother fucker you are going to die. He pushed him down on the ground and myself and others rescued the Congressman. I meticed blood on Congressman Ryan clothes. A couple minutes after this incident Jim Jones approached the Congressman and said he was sorry for what had happened. After this the Congreaman and his party with metflers left. After they left I went to the pavillion and then went to see my wife and son. At the pavillion Jim Jones, Mark Lane, Charles Gairy and several other persons were discussing the incident involving Don Siy and the Congressman. I did hear Marceline Jones came on the loud speaker and said everyone was to go back to their cottages. About half hour after, there was another call on the loud speaker requiring settlers to assemble at the pavillion. My wife and child went to pavillion. When I got there I saw a girl named Shirley Smith on the stage dancing and singing that she going to be a freedom fighter and appeared to me to have lost her mind. In the meantime Jim Jones, Charles Gairy, Mark Lane and others were under school: tent speaking. About half hour after I heard over the loud speaker the word "suicide". At that time I was speaking to Maria Katsarsia by the ape cage, this was opposite the house of Joyce Touchette; before this whilst I was at the pavillion some one asked me to get some water for Jim Jones and I went to the stage where girl was singing and dancing and collected a glass of water and gave to Johnny Jones. I think Johnny Jones asked me to get a glass of water for Marceline Jones. I passed on this message to a Murse and left going towards the radio room after Maria Katsarsis called me. Hyself, my brother, Michael Corter went into the room next to the radio room, she asked my help and that of my brother to assist Prokes to carry a heavy suit case. She told me to take my suit case to West House after I changed my clothes. I want home, changed my clothes, collected my H.T. suit case which I gave to a girl maned Carolyn Clayton at Yest House. Her mister Ann Elizabeth Moore spoke to me. She asked me to find Maria Katsaris and asked her (Maria Katsarsis) whether John Stoon and Kino Layton should go to the pavillion also. I went back in the direction of the pavillion, met Karia Katsarwis gave her the message and she told me to tell Ann Elizabeth Moore to leave them there for the time being. I heard the word

"Suicide". I became afreid and went over to the pavillion to see what was going on. I went over to the kitchen to collect some water; whilst there I heard wailing and crying coming from the direction of the pavillion. I went over to pavillion I saw between ten to fifteen bodies on the ground. I saw two lines behind the pavillion and appearing to be going up in some direction-I saw mothers kneeling down holding their children crying. I saw my wife kneeling down holding my son crying. I went over to her and saw the child dead. I hugged her and told her I love you. The place; it was agony. Whilst I was holding my wife she went into convulsion and I assumed she had taken the poison-At this point I left the pavillion and went back to West House. When I got there I saw my brother Michael Carter and Mike Prokes with the said suit came I had given to Carolyn Layton, 'I then left with thes behind the kitchen pass the generator, crossed the road and went at the end of the Banana Grove. The suit case was very heavy, when we got therewe buried some money, took some and put same in money helts. My brother warm one and I warm one. From there we went to the phicken area where we deposited the money in a chicken feed bag and left the suit case. In the suit case was a letter addressed to the Soviet Embassy, Georgetown. As we were going we were talking and I told Frokes and my brother about what I saw at the pavillion, Prokes said our destination is at the Datassy. I spent about half hour at the chicker fare and I left in the direction of Jonestown road, I did not see any vehicle going towards Jonestown on leaving. Whilst we were walking we were trying to avoid being seen as much as possible. We reached the Railway line and after resting a few times we finally reached Port Kaituma. I was going to the Police station at Port Kaituma. The whole thing was so unreal. I know the "Oudjoe" would normally be there. We were stopped under the light by a guard who had a gun and took us to a Police outpost twenty yards away. I made a report and Police took everything they found on me. I had no firearm. I had my passport. There were five passports. Two passports were with the letter which was addressed to Soviet Embassy. They were in an envelope. I saw them makes a note in a book. On Monday 20th Novamber, 1978 I want back with Police to Jonestown. I identified about twenty to twenty-five bodies to the Police. They were in the vicinity of the pavillion and not in the area where my son and wife were. I saw a lot of guns piled up in front of the radio room. I was identifying the

bodies with Odell Enodes and my brother. In the afternoon I with my brother and a Party of Pelice want to the balance field and there we recovered the money we buried.

I also worked as a School Teacher, teaching Eighischool students. I taught English to children in their Fid-terms. I also worked in the Cassava Crew. If I wanted to leave Jonestown I had to have a pass signed by one of the three persons: John Jones, Earriet Tropp or Carolyn Layton. On Friday 17th November, 1978 at about 4.00 p.m. I went to Port Kaituma Air Strip with four or five other settlers to welcome Congressman Ryan and his Party. I took into the settlement Congressman Ryan, his aids, Durgaand a man from the Ministry of Information in Guyana along with Mark Lane and Charles Gairy. Congressman Ryan after he was introduced he bagan to interview settlers. Jim Jones was in the pavillion talking to members of the News Media who came into Jonestown between half hour to one hour after. There was a dinner and show that night, everything appeared to be in order that night. Congressian Ryan and his side stayed at Jonestown that night whilst the other members of the News Media went away and came back the next day. The next day about Midday Mr. Dres reported that four to six settlers wished to leave eventually fifteen to sixteen settlers turned up to leave with the Congressman and his party. The Congressman and his party left settlement about 4.00 p.m. on 18th Mcvember, 1978. After they left Meria Katsarsis came rushing up to me telling me that a bunch of settlers gone to get Ryan and the situation is out of control and asked me to go down to her home and wait. This was the Vest House where Jim Jones lived. I did so. Tim Carter then came with a swit case and handed same to someone at the door. Tim Carter then left to carry a message, Maria Katsarsis spoke to me again saying the would be out in a few minutes. Ibout fifteen minutes after she came out without case and left same with me and asked me to wait for the Carters. She again went in and said she would be back out. I lived at Mac Alister Street, San Francisco, United States of America. I am an engineer member of the People's Temple Organisation. I came to Guyana in March, 1978 and went up to Jonestown three days after, It was in the said month. I remember Friday 17th November, 1978 when Congressman Ryan and his party arrived at Jonestonn. There was an entertainment on that might of 17th Movember, 1978. Tim Knight Jones about mineteen years of age came and told Me that I and Clifford Grig were to take the boat "Oudjoe" and go to Kumaka. I got the impression that Tim Knight Jones was told by someone to pass this message unto me as he had no authority as far as I know to do so. The "Oudjoe" at that time was moored at Port Kaituma. Ed Granishan drove truck which took myself and Clifford Grig to Kusaka. Clifford Grig was Captain and I was engineer. We left Jonestown about 8.30 in the morning on 18th Movember, 1978 for Port Kaituma. We took our luggage with us. We reached Fort Kaituma about 9.30 a.m. We checked engine and left Port Kaitums around 10 a.m. and reached Exzaka about 3.45 p.m. on that said day 16th Movember, 1978. I was told to wait until the next day and then take boat back to Port Kaituma. We remained there until about 12 O'clock that might when the Guyana Defence Force took charge of boat and took us to Mataruma Police Station. We had plenned to leave Kumaka about 9 0'clock on the morning of the 19th Ecvember, 1978 for Esituma. There was a V.H.F. set on the "Cudjoe". Clifford Grig could operate set; the set had a lented range and could not reach any place in the world. The set name "PACER". At the settlement was my mother Hazel Nevell 52 years of age. I see this document; exhibit "AS" No. 377; the person recorded is my mother, Shirley Bivards my sister she also died at Jonestown, her age about twenty-eights years old. On the said exhibit "AS" the name listed as No. 374 should be Christopher Nevell and not Christopher Revell. Carl Nevell age about sixteen years, Allan Nevell about fourteen years old. Jennifer Nevell about twelve years old, Isaac Edwards my mephew age about five years old, all of these persons were alive on 18th Movember, 1978 when I left Jonestown and were at Jonestown. Estween the 1st and 3rd December, 1978 in consequent of information received I recovered a further sum \$296.500 U.S. currency and \$11.398 (G.) currency. This money was found at Port Keituma. The money was found in the vicinity of a train line two and a half miles from Port Kaituma. I also found in my search at Jonestown this diary which was referred to in my swidence in chief. This diary was found at the side, I foot from the head of Ann Elizabeth Moore. I also found a fireare right next to the body of the said Ann Elizabeth Moore, the said firears was covered in blood. It was a "Ruger" .357 Magnum, the firearm could have caused injury to the said Ann Elizabeth Moore. This is the said firearm tendered, admitted and marked exhibit 'H'. Magnum firearm is one of the most powerful hand gun manufactured in the world. Enger prints could not be lifted from same as it was covered in blood. I also found this Organisational chart tendered, admitted and marked exhibit J. Witness reads names recorded thereon. CHCIL BOB SHYS Re-Sworn States:-

This is a further document which I got from the United States Embassy in Guyana in respect to the dead bodies that were taken from Ruyana on Monday in Mortuary in the United States of America. I now say that I observed what appeared to be gun shot wound on unidentified body of a Caucasian male of about six feet tall in a room described to me by Odell Rhodes as a physiatric ward.
