2 This Act may be cited as the "Video Privacy Protec-3 tion Act Amendments Act of 2012".

4 SEC. 2. VIDEO PRIVACY PROTECTION ACT AMENDMENT.

5 Section 2710(b)(2) of title 18, United States Code,
6 is amended by striking subparagraph (B) and inserting
7 the following:

"(B) to any person with the informed, written 8 9 consent (including through an electronic means 10 using the Internet) of the consumer that— 11 "(i) is in a form distinct and separate from 12 any form setting forth other legal or financial 13 obligations of the consumer; "(ii) at the election of the consumer— 14 "(I) is given at the time the disclosure 15 16 is sought; or "(II) is given in advance for a set pe-17 18 riod of time, not to exceed 2 years or until 19 consent is withdrawn by the consumer, 20 whichever is sooner; and 21 "(iii) the video tape service provider has 22 provided an opportunity, in a clear and con-

23 spicuous manner, for the consumer to withdraw

on a case-by-case basis or to withdraw from on going disclosures, at the consumer's election;".
