



Supplementary Figure 3. Cue-evoked dopamine release after extended conditioning. **(a)** Mean differential dopamine concentration for 5 s after CS+ (blue trace) and CS- (red trace) onset. CS+ evoked NAc [DA] was significantly elevated from baseline levels at 0.3–1.4 s after cue onset (blue asterisks; $p < 0.05$ for each comparison). CS- evoked [DA] was significantly increased from baseline levels at 0.4–0.5 s after cue onset (red asterisks; $p < 0.05$ for each contrast). **(b)** CS+/CS- difference score ((CS+ [DA]) - (CS- [DA])) during the same time period. CS+ evoked [DA] was significantly higher than CS- evoked [DA] at 0.5–0.8 s after cue onset (*95% CI does not include zero).
