## Deputy Political Editor Nate Hurst Promoted –

**July 26, 2021** -- C-SPAN today announces the promotion of Nate Hurst to Political Editor. He will oversee C-SPAN's campaign coverage including races for the White House, Congress, state and local elections of national importance.

Hurst has served as C-SPAN's deputy political editor since 2019. He joined the network in 2014 and has held several vital roles regularly producing Congressional hearings, international legislatures, and the U.N. He's also produced original C-SPAN content including season two of C-SPAN's "Landmark Cases" and "January 6: Views from the House."

Prior to C-SPAN, Hurst reported on federal transportation policy for *CQ Roll Call*. He is also the former Washington correspondent for *The Detroit News* where he covered the Obama White House and Congress. Hurst is a graduate of Emerson College and a 2010-11 Paul Miller Fellow of the National Press Foundation.
