MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

In September, in honor of Argosy's 25th Anniversary, the foundation was able to take advantage of a moment of relative calm during the COVID storm to bring together all our Trustees and staff members in one place for the first time in years. This small retreat, which included a board meeting and a celebration, was not only a much-needed moment for team bonding, but also an incredible opportunity to honor all that has been accomplished in the past quarter century by so many. We watched inspiring video testimonials from many of our long-time partners on the importance of Argosy support to their vital community efforts and even played a fun round of Argosy-themed trivia.

These few days together were an important celebration of the past and a re-commitment to our mission of supporting people and programs that make our society a better place to live. They were also an opportunity for continued deep reflection. Just as COVID has caused individuals and societies to rethink and readjust everything from public health, to parenting, to professions, it has also provided an opportunity to reexamine our approach to philanthropy in important ways. The following short summaries are just a few of the new initiatives and efforts Argosy undertook in 2021:

- Anti-Racism Advisory Committee: recognizing that our commitment to more actively examine our grant-making through the lens of racial equity was important, but not sufficient, we piloted an Advisory Committee model that brought together accomplished leaders working on racial justice and community development to take the lead on identifying, evaluating, and making grants towards community groups working in this space. The committee's dedicated efforts, and helpful feedback, will guide us in a second year of this project and allow us to expand the advisory model to an additional focus in the future.
- Spectrum of Investments: while grantmaking remains an integral part of our model, we continue to implement a full spectrum of support for innovative and important work with venture investments in areas including, but not limited to regenerative agriculture, reproductive health, and education. We're also continuing our efforts to ensure our financial holdings are invested in line with our foundation's values.
- Staff Growth: one lesson of COVID was the recognition that work and workplaces can take many shapes. As two new staff members joined our team, not only were we able to add expertise in key areas like research and grant management that will allow us and our partners to be more effective, we also added a new office. Staff are now located in Birmingham, AL, Boulder, CO, and Milwaukee, WI. This has helped us connect more meaningfully with new communities, regions, and partners.

Beyond considering how we work, the continued challenges of the year (including COVID, mis and disinformation, devastating climate change-fueled disasters, attacks on reproductive freedom, and so much more) have also been key to considering deeper questions guiding why we give. In a climate that seems to reward anger and mistrust, how do we approach our giving through the lens of kindness, compassion, and empathy? In a society that seems to prioritize the loudest and most extreme voices, how do we encourage honest conversations that forward understanding? In a world that often seems depressing and scary, how do we get people to laugh and use comedy and culture as a force for good? We certainly don't have all the answers (or all the questions, for that matter) but we remain committed to exploring them with the help of so many of you.


INVESTMENTS AND EXPENSES


Operating & Administrative Expenses in 2021: \$1,432,979.00
