

2022 Annual Report

Today, it is remarkably easy to immerse ourselves in information bubbles that promise community but instead offer increasing isolation; bubbles that claim they are singularly equipped to be sources of reality and truth but instead restrict us to an ever-narrower range of perspectives and people. From social media algorithms designed to enrage and confine us to the rhetoric of our tribes to news outlets highlighting the latest culture wars and controversies rather than meaningful context and considerations of current events, it has never been easier to focus on what is wrong than how we can work to make things right.

What makes the work of our partners so inspiring and critical is that rather than getting caught up in outrage or despair, even when they might be fully justified to do so, they instead choose to find solutions to transform that outrage or tragedy into action that helps improve, rather than inflame, the situation. When the Supreme Court's *Dobbs* decision overturned decades of precedent and threw the health and safety of millions of Americans into doubt, <u>Plan C</u> became a vital resource for ensuring anyone who needed to access safe, effective at-home abortion options wasn't left in the dark. When COVID and inflation continued putting pressure on the already overburdened organizations fighting food insecurity, groups like <u>412 Food Rescue</u> combined innovation and the power of people who just want to assist to help transform and feed entire communities. These partners also demonstrate that while technology can create problems, it can also be a solution with the right intention and planning.

Many of our partners are building new systems that address complex problems with community and collaboration oriented approaches. <u>The National Trust For Local News</u> is innovating entirely new models for revitalizing and protecting local news that is the backbone of communities' civic, cultural, and information needs. Radio Milwaukee's <u>By Every Measure</u> podcast is expanding the conversation on racial disparities by examining the hard data underlying key sectors and systems and the potential practical solutions.

While we value this commitment to innovation and adaptation by all the incredible groups you can find in this Annual Report, we also know that same spirit we seek in our partners must underly the work we do internally. This past year we continued our commitment to listening and learning in an effort to pop our own information bubbles: from enhancing our use of advisory committees to broaden the voices in our decision-making to exploring and learning from the innovative philanthropic models being piloted by our peers. While we are committed to evolving our strategies, the why remains the same- to support people and programs that make our society a better place to live.

If the past few years have taught us anything, it's to expect the unexpected. Dramatic disruption and perilous progress appear to be the new normal, which can be scary, but it's also an opportunity to adapt and grow. What if instead of anger and resentment, our communal struggles led to increased empathy and understanding for our neighbors next door. What if technology, instead of isolating us into likeminded groups, allowed us to expand our concept of a neighbor, to people living very different lives in very different places than us? What if our response to this new normal was not one rooted in fear or judgement but in curiosity and hope? Argosy is committed to evolving our approach to our mission while always letting kindness and understanding be the foundation of our work.

By operating in a manner consistent with our values, we hope our methodology and integrity will earn respect. We value diversity and differences of opinion regarding our decisions and actions.




 Operating & Administrative Expenses in 2022:
